SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

- First-aid measures general : Call a poison center/doctor/physician if you feel unwell.
- First-aid measures after inhalation : Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing.
- First-aid measures after skin contact medical : Wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get immediate advice/attention. Get medical advice/attention. Specific treatment (see Wash skin with plenty of water, Call a physician immediately on this label). Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash skin with plenty of water. Take off contaminated clothing. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention.
- First-aid measures after eye contact Rinse : If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. Get medical advice/attention. cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Call a physician immediately.
- First-aid measures after ingestion poison : Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Rinse mouth. Call a center/doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

4.2. Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

- Symptoms/effects after inhalation : May cause an allergic skin reaction.
- Symptoms/effects after skin contact : Irritation. May cause an allergic skin reaction.
- Symptoms/effects after eye contact : Causes serious eye irritation. Serious damage to eyes.
- Symptoms/effects after ingestion : Swallowing a small quantity of this material will result in serious health hazard.

4.3. Indication of any immediate medical attention and special treatment needed

Treat symptomatically.
