4.1. Description of necessary first-aid measures

- : Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If you feel unwell, seek medical advice (show the label where possible).
- : Allow affected person to breathe fresh air. Allow the victim to rest.
- : Wash with plenty of water/.... If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. Specific treatment (see supplemental first aid instruction on this label). Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by warm water rinse. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention.
- : Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if pain, blinking or redness
- : Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention.
