The Maker Manager Program is designed to give educators and community leaders the support needed to build active Maker communities that embrace the Maker Mindset. Effective Maker Education communities are intentionally built with parent, student, and community support and have students at their core. The Maker Manager Program supports educators and community leaders through the process of developing, assessing, and sustaining a makerspace, STEM Lab, or innovation space with a 9-month blend of synchronous and asynchronous exploration that fosters a Maker Mindset amongst participants.
