PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Reefton Distilling Co. Limited (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 10 Smith Street, Reefton and known as "Reefton Distilling Co.", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

If this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1.00 pm a)
- Alcohol may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours: Monday to b) Sunday 9:00am till 8:00pm.
- Drinking water must be freely available for patrons where complimentary samples are being offered. c)
- A Host Responsibility Policy must be maintained and displayed and all staff must receive training on d) responsibilities and obligations under the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
- e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition of sales to intoxicated persons.
- The following parts of the premises are designated as: f) Undesignated: Entire Premises
- Sections 56-57 of the Act requires the licence holder to display the following at each principal entrance g) to the premises so as to be easily read by persons immediately outside the entrance: (i) Signage stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol; and (ii) A copy of the licence including conditions.
- Section 214(3) of the Act requires signage to be displayed inside the premises which identifies by name h) the manager for the time being on duty.

## Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either-
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire. either
  - until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
