



What you'll need

- 8" x 8" or larger 14 count Aida cloth
- 6" embroidery hoop
- 7" embroidery hoop (optional)
- Tapestry needle or similar
- Scissors
- DMC 6 strand embroidery floss

Tips for Stitching

- Use two strands of thread.

- Don't knot your thread to anchor it, your stitches will do that for you.

- Use pins to place your pattern and to keep track of the pattern as you jump to different sections.

- Always make your stitches in the same direction, either left over right or right over left.

 For rows with multiple stitches of the same color, make a row of half stitches \ \ \ first, then go back and complete the Xs with / / stitches.

- When you're finished, dampen the cloth and iron it before you display it.
