

## BIOFA NATOLE Sanitary Cleaner Concentrate Item no. 4060

### Characteristics

NATOLE Sanitary Cleaner is a concentrated cleanser made from natural raw materials. It is suitable for cleaning all surfaces in the bathroom, kitchen and toilet. It gently and environmentally friendly loosens and cleans away dirt, lime and urine scales from tiles, basins, tubs, toilet bowls, urinal systems, fittings etc. It is biodegradable and adds a natural and fresh cleanliness.

### Ingredients

Water, citric acid, <5% anionic and amphoteric surfactant from coconut fat, formic acid, ethanol, polysaccharide / starch, lavandin oil, peppermint oil, colorants, silver sulfate.

### Directions

Using a nozzle, spray on the surface to be cleaned, making sure to get in niches and under pool edges, etc. Use a brush or a sponge to distribute. Allow to take effect and then thoroughly rinse off.

To avoid staining chromed surfaces, the treated surface may be dry-polished.

### Storage

Store tightly closed in a cool, frost-free, dry place.

### Containers

0,5 L / 1 L / 5 L PET-bottles

### Disposal

If possible, use up entire product. Liquid product residues may be disposed of according to local/national regulations.

Only completely emptied and cleaned bottles may be recycled.
