## HOW TO USE ICE.MADE.CLEAR.․․

1. FILL


* Wash base and trays with mild soap before using. Do not use a dishwasher.
a. Fill the base with regular tap water $2 / 3$ rds of the way up.
b. Place a tray in the base and fill to the top edge with tap water.


## 2. FREEZE

Place I.M.C.' ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ in your freezer. Let cubes freeze. $1.25{ }^{\prime \prime}$ cubes will require 6 -10 hours to freeze. $2^{\prime \prime}$ cubes will need 12-24 hours.

## 3. REMOVE


a. Place I.M.C.'T on counter. Hold handle and pull slowly but firmly upward, peeling the silicone tray up and out of the base.
b. If the tray is too difficult to remove, run a bit of hot tap water down the back of the handle, then try removing the tray.

## USE AGAIN

Remove any water or ice from the base before using again. Run hot tap water into the base until ice is loose. Note: ice may be sharp.

## ICE.MADE.CLEAR. ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ TIPS \& TRICKS

* Place I.M.C. in the freezer where there are no vents blowing air directly over it.
- For the most perfect ice, use very hot tap water (this may slow freezing). Never use boiling water.

Distilled / Purified tap or bottled water is not recommended. Spring water is ok.
I.M.C. is denser than traditional ice. let the cubes sit for a few minutes before using so they do not crack.
© From time to time, 1-2 cubes may have a small amount of cloudy water on top after freezing. This is a surface artifact only, and can be rinsed off or dissolved quickly in a drink.

Rarely, one or two of the cubes might extrude upward when freezing. Simply discard these cubes if you wish.

Caution: Leftover ice in the base after freezing can be sharp.
