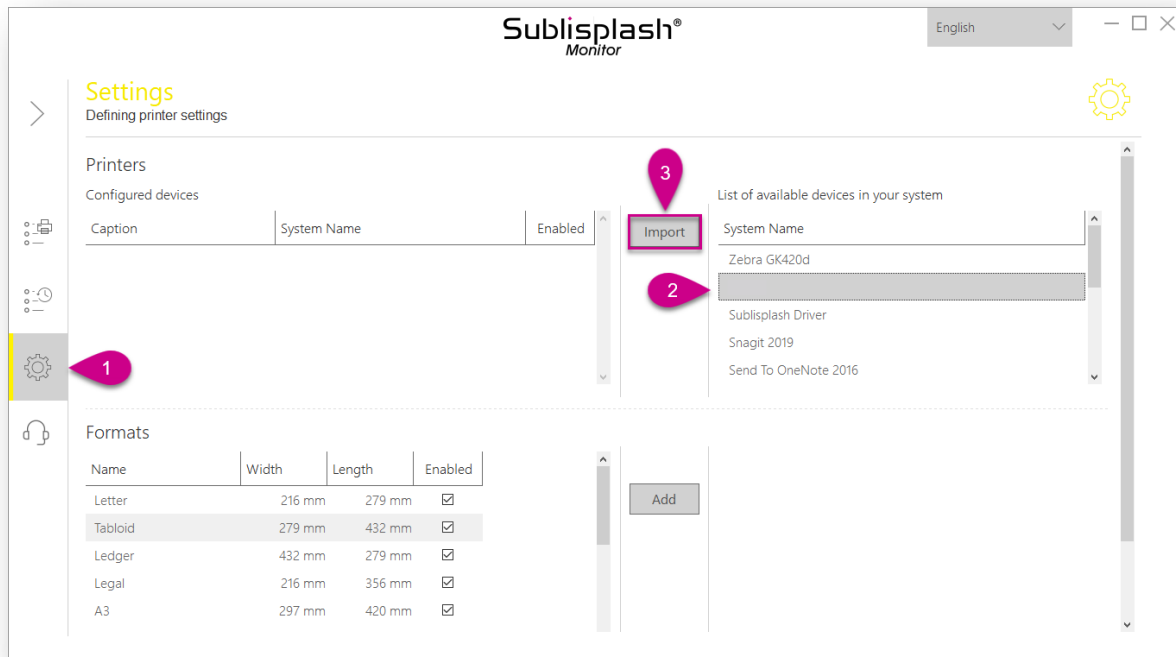
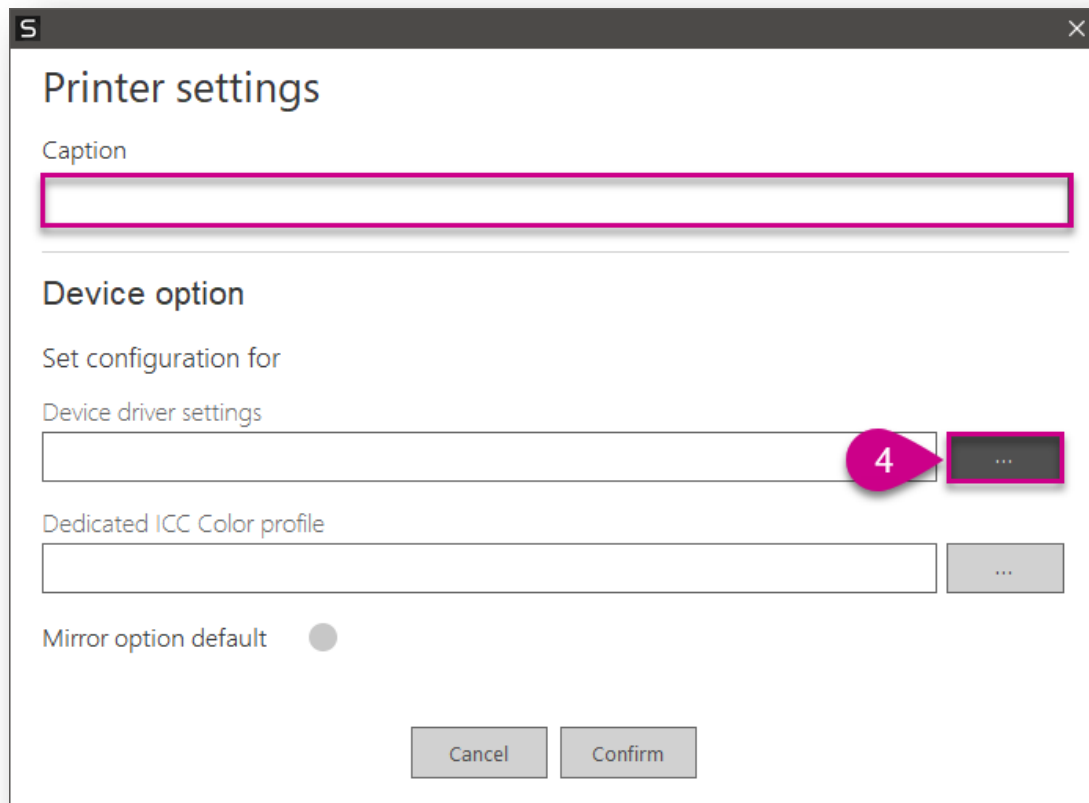


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1. Open the Sublisplash Monitor and click the settings tab on the left.
2. Select the printer you would like to configure within the Sublisplash Monitor.
3. Click Import



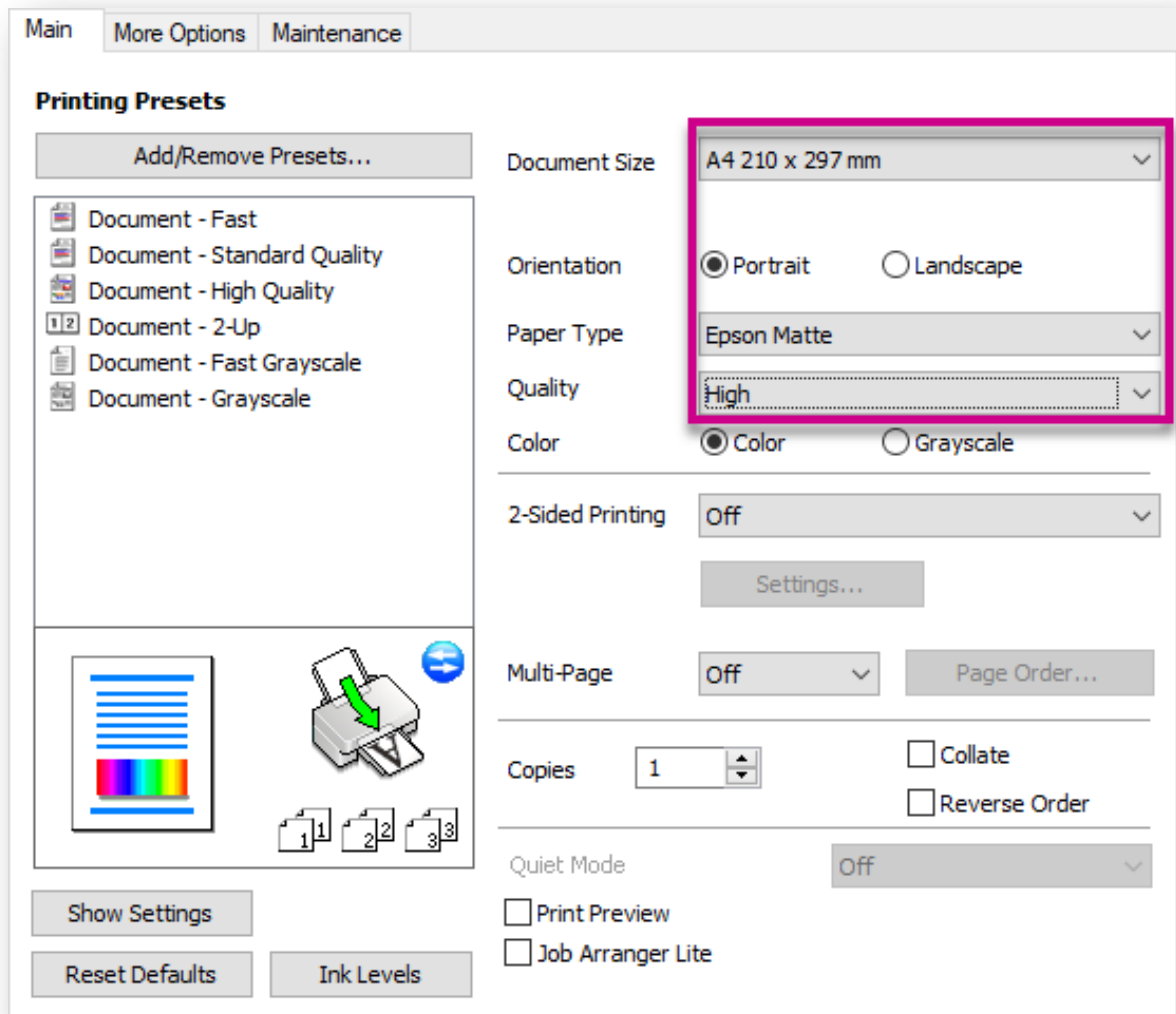
4. Click the ... box to begin configuration.
In the caption box, you can amend the text if needed.



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5. Open the 'Main' tab.

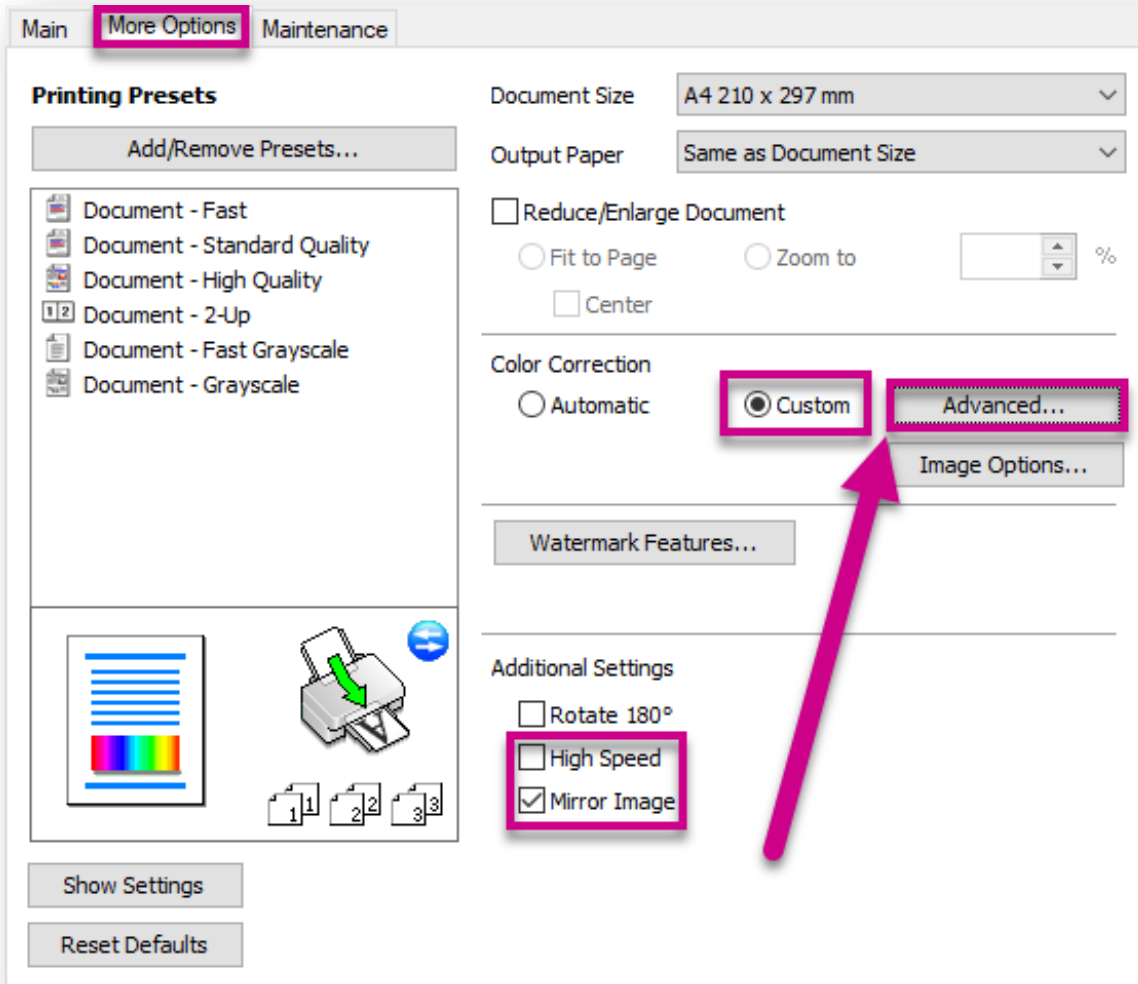
This is where you will set your paper size, orientation, type and quality.
We are selecting 'A4' 'Portrait' 'Epson Matte' and High as shown below.



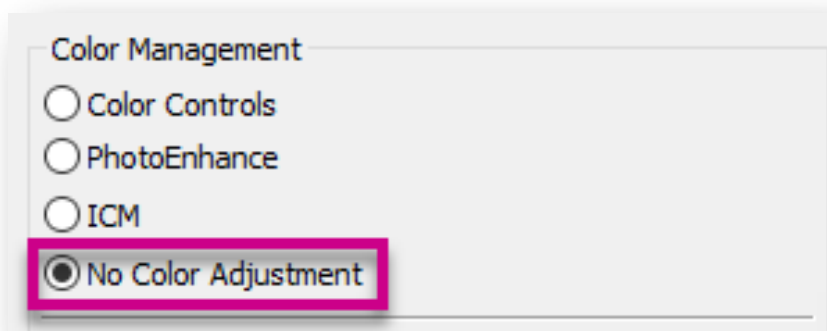
You can select 'Standard' quality to give a faster print speed. This option will work on many substrates. You can also create a 'Standard' setting under the presets to give both options.

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6. Open the 'More Options' tab.
Make sure 'High Speed' is unchecked.
Check the 'Mirror Image' box.

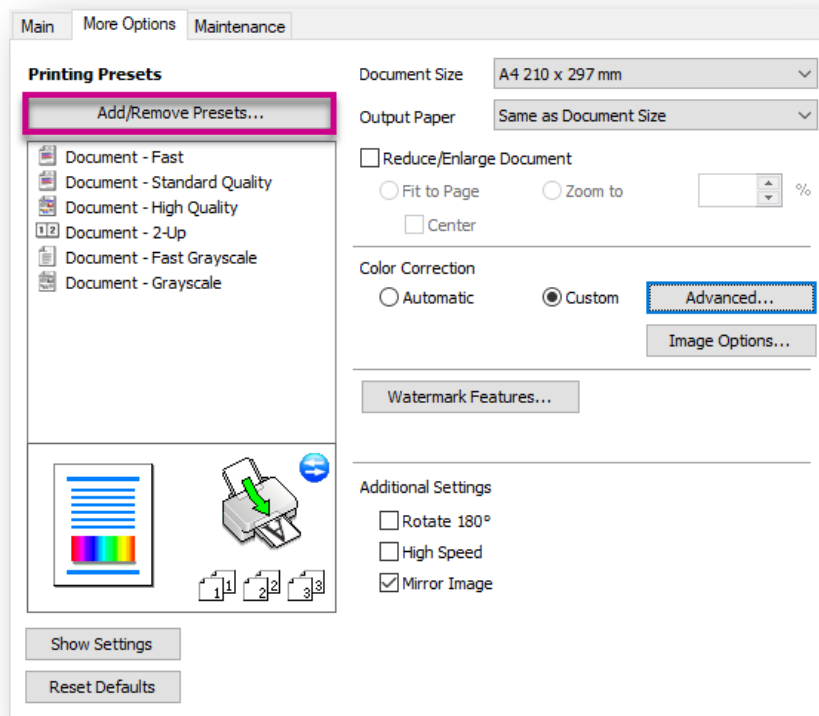


- Click on 'Custom' then 'Advanced'.
Set the color correction to 'No Color Adjustment'.
Click OK

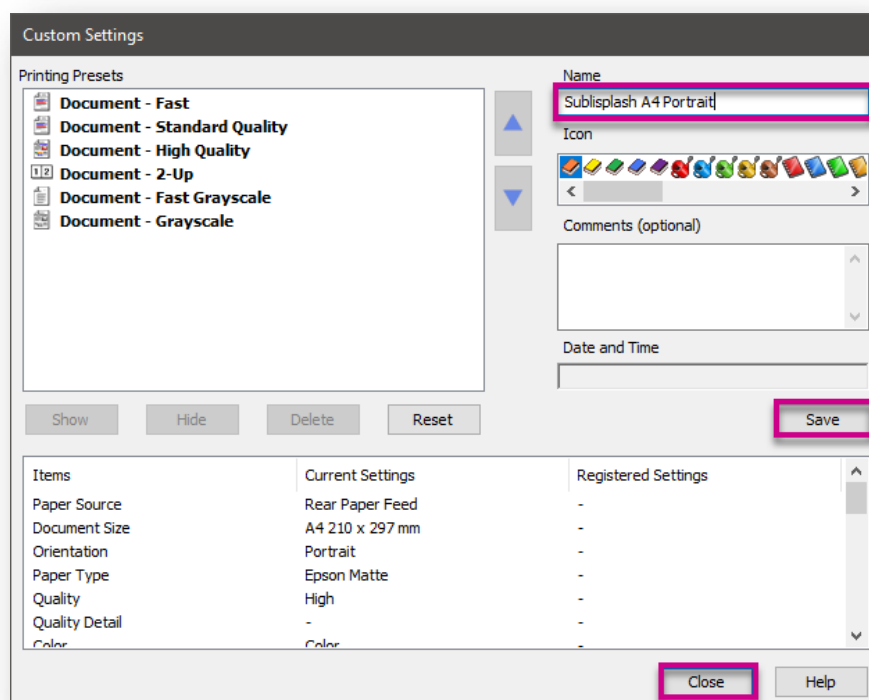


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7. Click on 'Add/Remove Presets...'

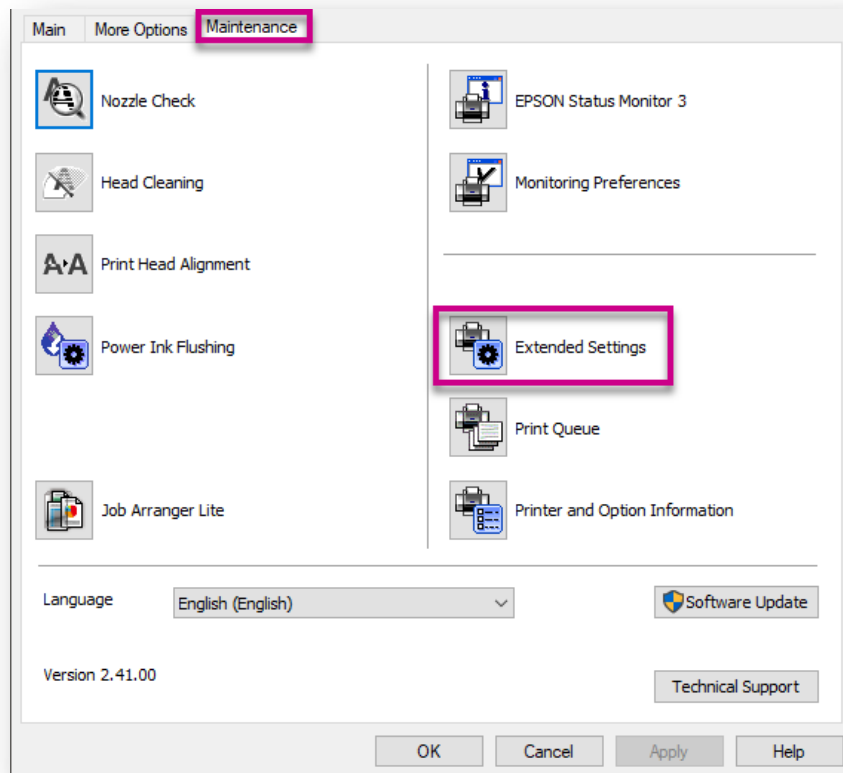


8. Enter a relevant one click preset name that describes the way you have setup your driver. In this case we have used 'Sublisplash A4 Portrait'. You can also enter comments if required. Once complete, click 'Save' then 'Close'.
Click OK.



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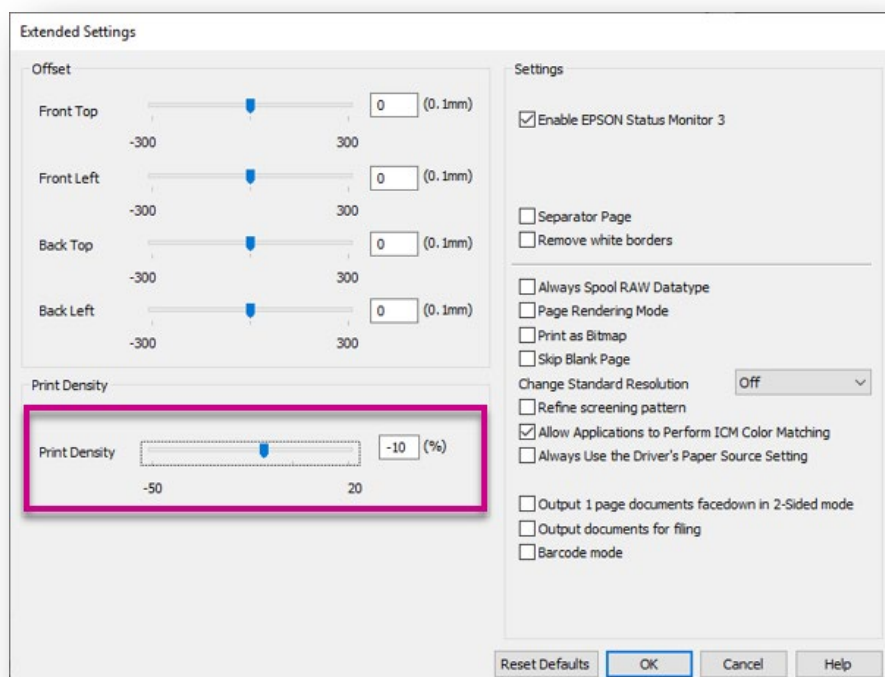
9. Open the 'Maintenance' Tab.
Click on 'Extended Settings'.



You can move the 'Print Density' slider to a plus or minus value.

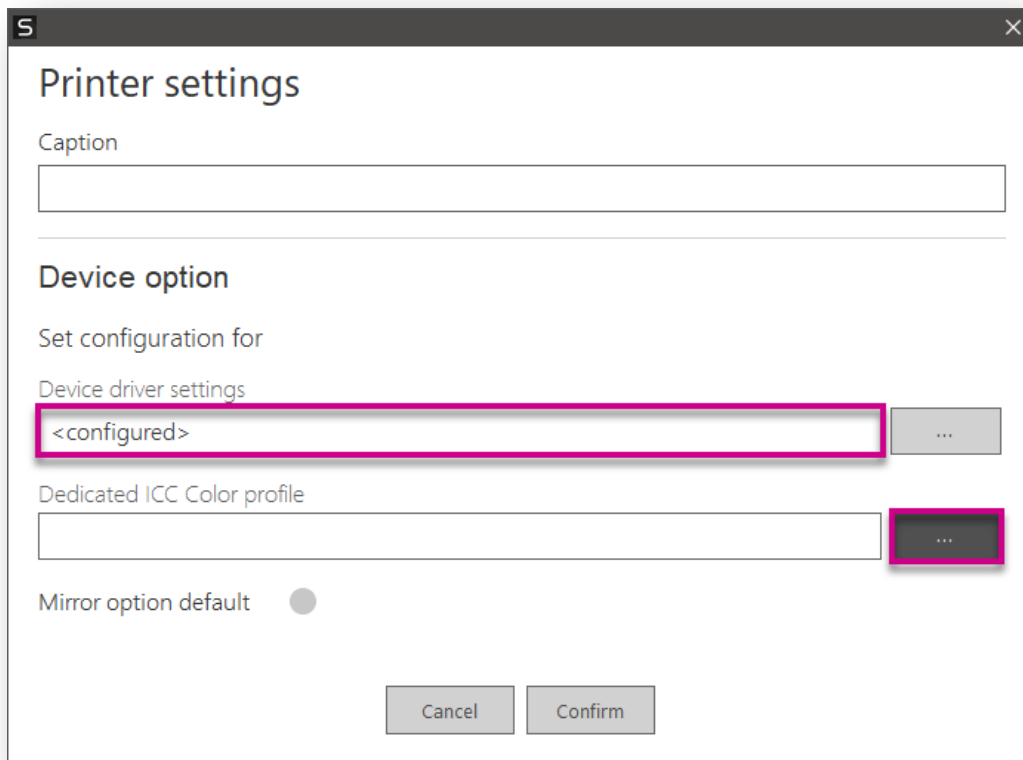
In the example below we show a -10% density. This is useful if you are suffering with too much ink saturation on certain papers or film.

Only change this if you are experiencing ink saturation.

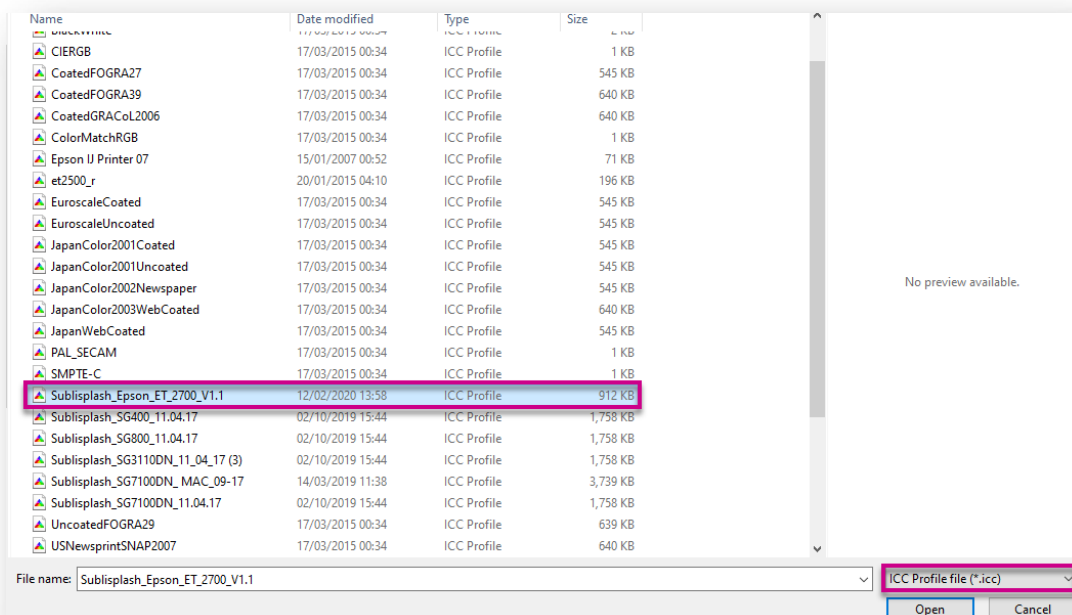


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10. Our device driver settings will now show as <configured>
Click the ... box next to dedicated ICC color profile to choose the correct profile.



11. Please follow our instructions regarding installation of the color profile.
If you have followed those instructions, the default folder location will be:
C:\Windows\System32\spool\drivers\color
Select the correct profile for your printer, and click open.
You can switch between .icc and .icm file types in the bottom right to view all profile options.



12. You have successfully completed all options and can click confirm.
