


HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE:

Before printing this ring sizing guide, make sure to set your printer to 100%.


Once printed, use a ruler to confirm the printed paper size in the box to the right. This is important because if the page does not print correctly, your ring size will not be accurate.



Make sure to measure your finger at normal body temperature and a few times throughout the day to make sure your ring size is as accurate as possible.

FINDING YOUR RING SIZE:

- 1. Using a ruler, measure the diameter of a well-fitting ring that you already own (in mm). Check your size using our ring sizing chart.
- 2. Lay your ring over the circles above until you are able to match the *inside* edge of your ring with one of the circles. You should be able to see the black line inside the ring.
- 3. If you are between two sizes, order the quarter size in the middle (i.e. 6.75).
