


HOW TO DETERMINE RING SIZE

FIRST CONFIRM THIS PRINTED PAPER IS TO SCALE



- 1. For accuracy please ensure that this pdf is printed at 100%
- 2. Once printed, measure the scale to the left with a ruler to ensure that it matches 1 inch or 30mm long. If the measurement is not accurate, please ensure your printer settings are at full size and reprint before continuing.

CIRCLES SHOW RING SIZE AND DIAMETERS



MEASURE CURRENT RING

- 1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
- **2.** Match the inside edge of the ring to the nearest circle in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
- **3.** If the ring falls between two sizes, quarter sizes are available upon special request.

Use inside diameter of the ring and circle

TIPS FOR BUYING THE RING AS A SURPRISE

- Ask your significant other's friends or family if they know their finger size.
- Borrow one of your significant other's rings (from the correct finger) and use the ring measurements to determine its size.
