



Ring Size Estimator

Instructions

Step 1: Using the reference line above use a ruler to make sure the reference line measures exactly 3.5 inches , 88.9mm or 8.89cm.

Step 2: Print this paper on US LETTER SIZED PAPER in LANDSCAPE orientation, then cut out the sizer along the dashed lines.

VERY IMPORTANT: Do NOT check "Fit to Page" or use scaling. Select "Actual Size" as your print layout option.

Step 3: Cut a slit on the sizer where its marked "read size here".

Step 4: Take the pointed end and wrap around your finger tightly but not so tight that it cant move around a little. Insert the pointed end through the slit that you cut.

Step 5: Your approximate ring size should be read through the slit. Remember it's an approximate reading.

Tips

Remember that the best way to get an accurate ring sizing is to use a proper jewelers ring sizer. Most local jewelry shops will measure you for free. We do not guarantee the complete accuracy of this printable guide as there are too many variables such as paper size, and printer settings.

Its best to measure your finger when it is warm.

Any of our products labeled as "nail rings" should be sized taking into account that they sit below the knuckle. Read our sizing guide on our website for product specific information.

If the reference line above does not measure correctly on a ruler, then do not use this guide.
