*Any plant with a 'P' is a perennial and any plant with an 'A' is a self-seeding annual. Once you have planted this seed mix, these wonderful plants will be with you year after year!*

### Planting and Care Instructions

Our recommended seeding ratio is 150g per 500-1000 sq ft; if you plant in a site that previously had a strong weed pressure, seed at the denser rate. Choose an area that gets full sun and prepare the planting location by removing weeds and loosening the soil 1-2 inches deep. Once the site is ready, broadcast the seeds, and gently tamp into the soil.

Water as needed during the first growing season, using a sprinkler is recommended.

The seeds can be planted in the spring from early May to mid-June or in the fall from mid-September to late October. The seeds will be naturally stratified if planted in the fall or in late March or early April, although the seeds may need to be gently raked or packed into the seedbed if there has been a frost.
