Endometriosis – why is it my concern as a man?


Women with endometriosis, uterine prolapse, after hysterectomy or with myoma sometimes have bleeding or pain during sex.

One or more soft Bumpi® rings are stretched with two hands and pulled up to the penis shaft directly in front of the testicles before penetration. Depending on the number of Bumpi® rings used, the depth of penetration can be individually adjusted. To pull off, the rings are also stretched again and can thus be removed.
