#### **Teacher-Directed Activity**

Create a colorful display as a reminder of safe play & seasonal dress during favorite winter activities.

#### You'll Need:

- T10657 Winter Play Classic Accents<sup>®</sup> Variety Pack
- T85122 Winter Wonder Bolder Borders®

T432 Red 2" Casual Uppercase Ready Letters®

Double stick tape, colored and white paper, yarn, and markers or crayons

### Directions:

Make safety "cool" with a bright presentation showing kids dressed and playing safely in winter.

• Adjust the length of the border to fit your space. Use several short pieces, or create one long display.

- Supply a variety of colored paper and art supplies for students to create drawings. Encourage kids to show winter wear, like hats, mittens, boots, and to draw activities where they are playing safely.
- Attach finished artwork to pieces of colored paper and invite students to sign their drawings.
- Punch holes in the top of the accents and student drawings and add a length of yarn. Hang from the border as space allows.
- For long displays, use Ready Letters<sup>®</sup> to add other whimsical messages along the top, like "Winter Welcome," "Cool!" and "Snow Fun!"
