

# Tabletop Holiday Trees

Create winter-themed tabletop trees to celebrate the season & decorate any space!



## Supplies:

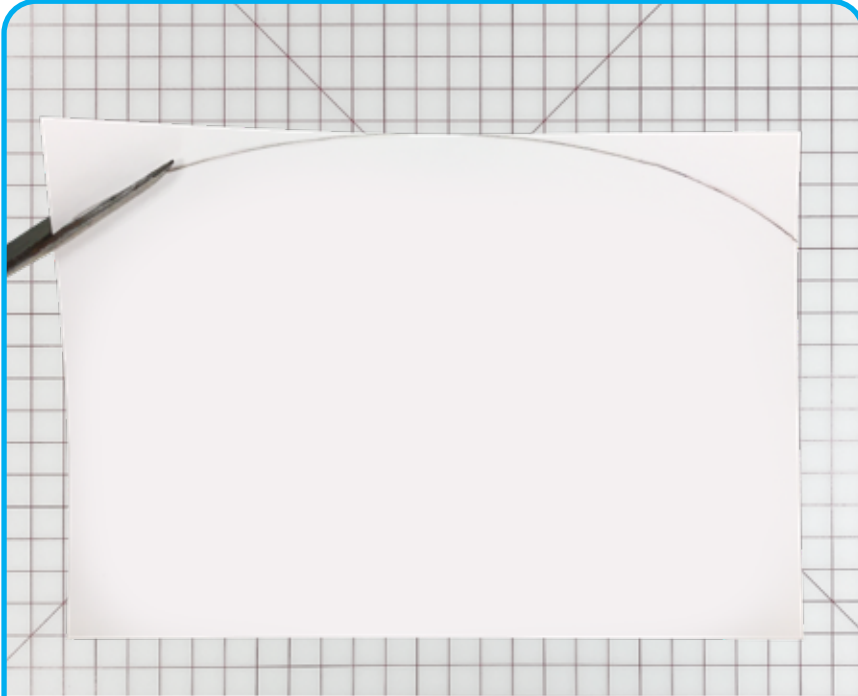
*Many trimmer/border designs work well; we chose this one for extra winter FUN!*

- 3 Terrific Trimmers® strips (T92164 Snow and Ice)
- 1 piece of thick paper (8½" x 11")
- Cone template (included)
- Scissors
- Pen or Pencil
- Tape
- Glue



# Step-by-Step Instructions:

## 1. Make the base.



*Use the included template to cut an arch along the long edge of the paper. This will be the open side of the cone.*



*Roll into a cone and glue (or tape) to hold in place.*

## 2. Make the branches.



*Draw teardrop shapes for the tree branches.*



*Cut out about 39 of them.*



## Step-by-Step Instructions (continued):

### 3. Build the tree.



*Curl each branch on the edge of a table or counter.*



*Glue each piece into place, starting at the bottom of the cone.*



*Continue overlapping branches up the cone until you're **almost** to the top. Leave room for just one more!*

### 4. Top the tree.



*Top the tree with 3 pointy, teardrop shaped branches. Tape their edges together on the back side as shown.*



*Finish the top piece by taping the last two edges together to form a cone shape. Place on top of the tree and secure with glue.*
