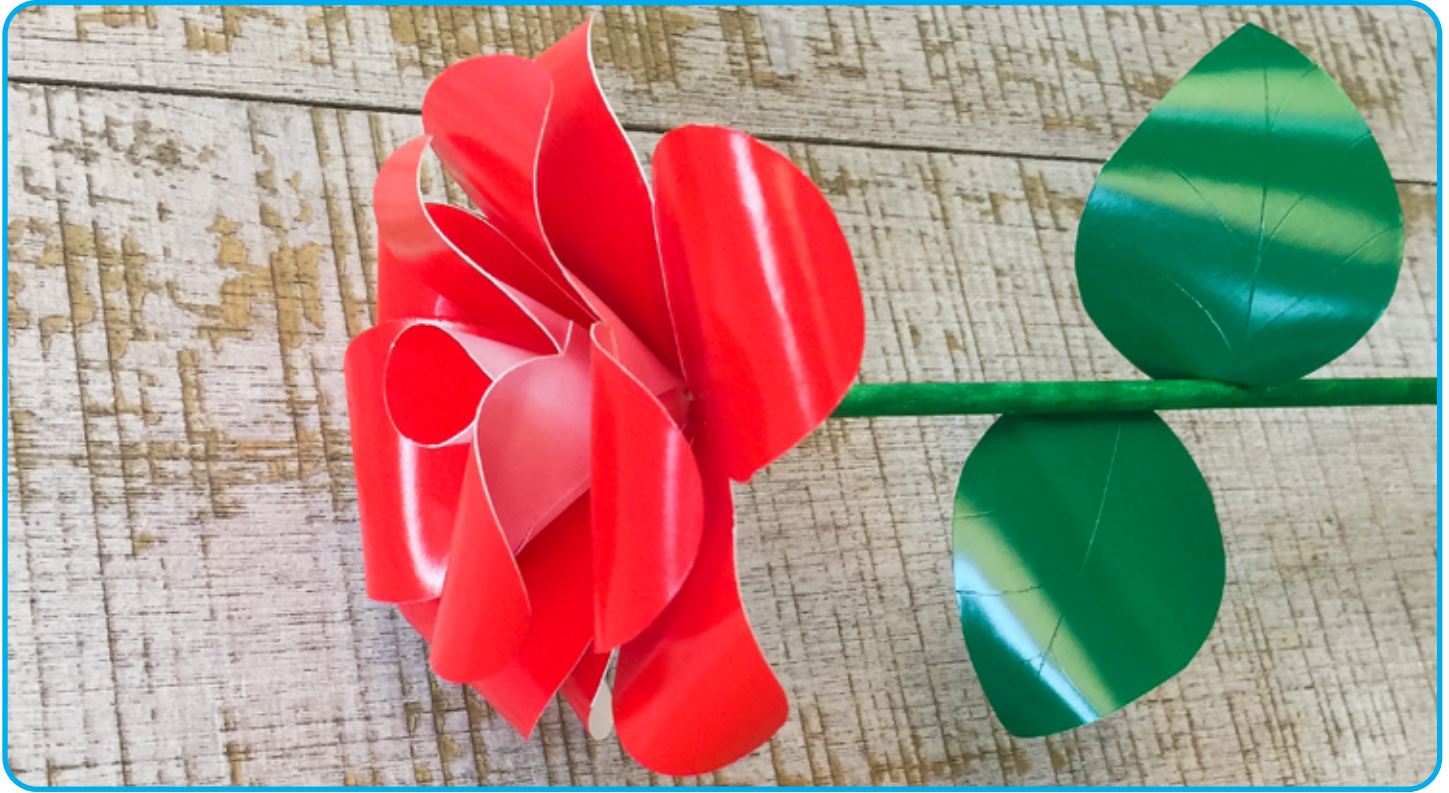


Create beautiful roses for decorations and gifts for Valentine's Day or anytime!



SUPPLIES:

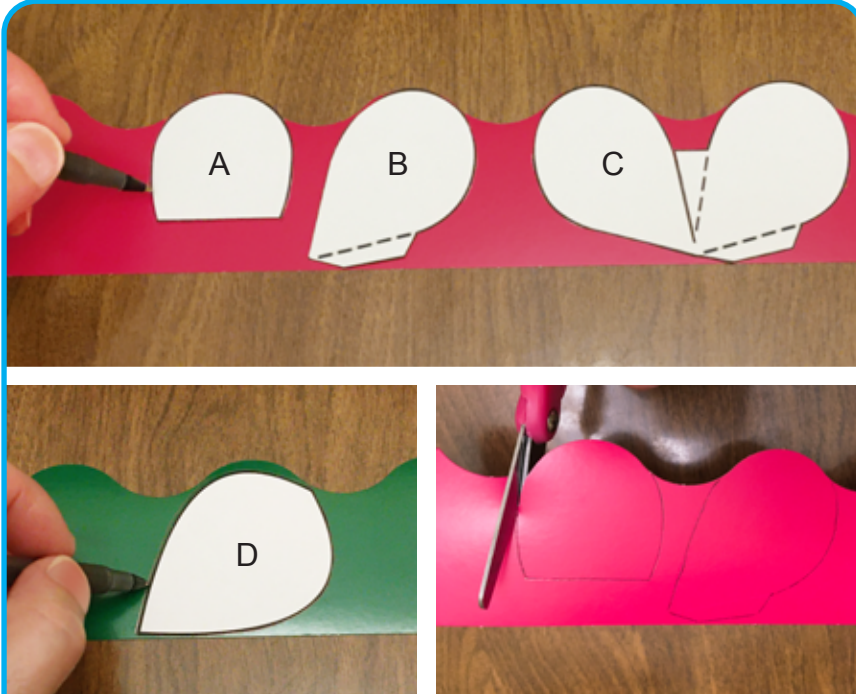
Try different trimmer/border designs for a look that's all your own!

- 2 Terrific Trimmers® strips (T9877 Red & T91316 Kelly Green)
- Flower template (included)
- Rubber band
- Pixie pin or bouquet pin
- Scissors
- Green marker
- Pen or pencil
- Glue
- Wooden dowel



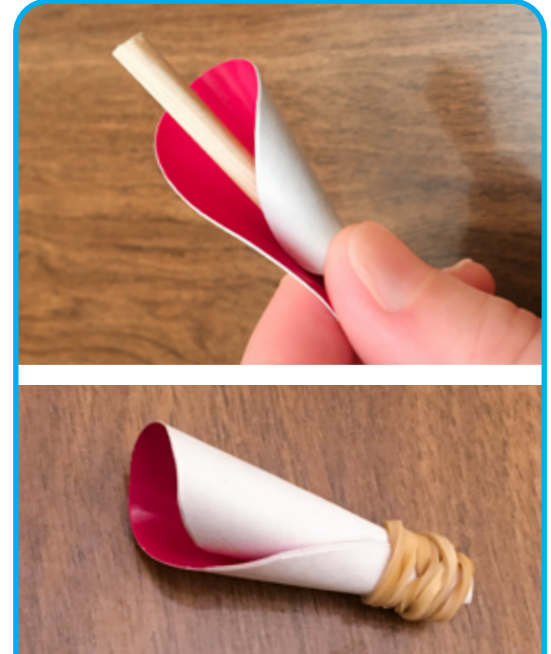
Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Trace & cut out all petals and leaves



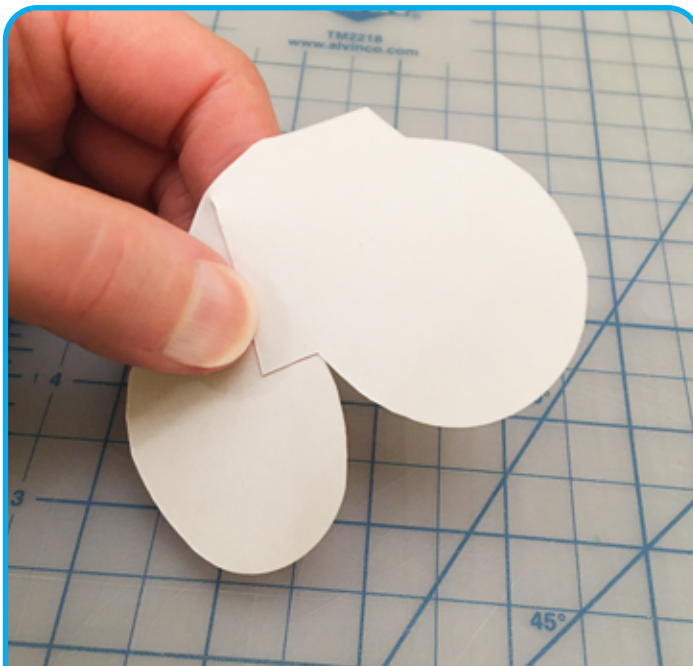
Use the included template to trace all parts onto trimmer strips. **Parts A, B & C** are for the petals. **Part D** is for the leaves. Refer to the template for quantities.

2. Make flower center (Part A)

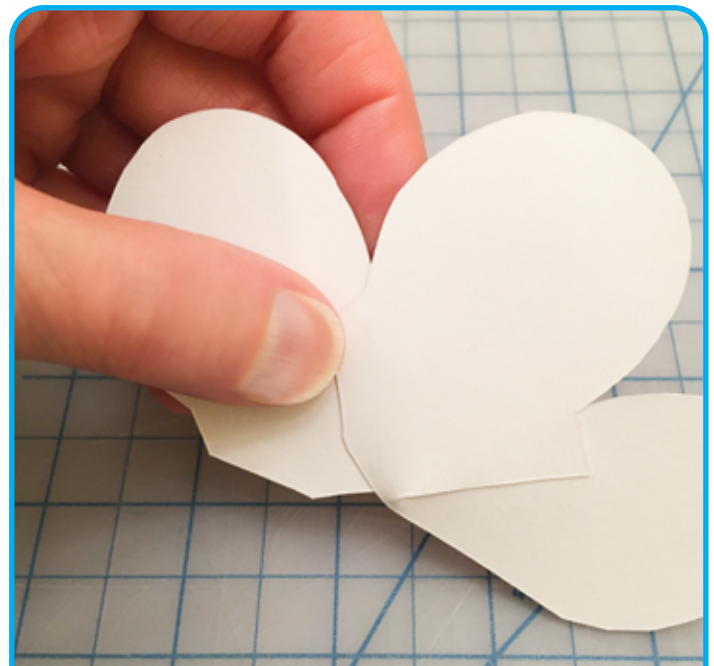


Use the dowel to roll **Part A** into a cone and glue together. Use a rubber band to hold until dry. This is the center of the flower.

3. Make petal layer 1 (Part B & Part C)



Glue the center tab on **Part C** to the petal shape next to it and hold until dry.



Glue the outside tab on **Part C** to **Part B** (leaving the tab on **Part B** open) as shown.

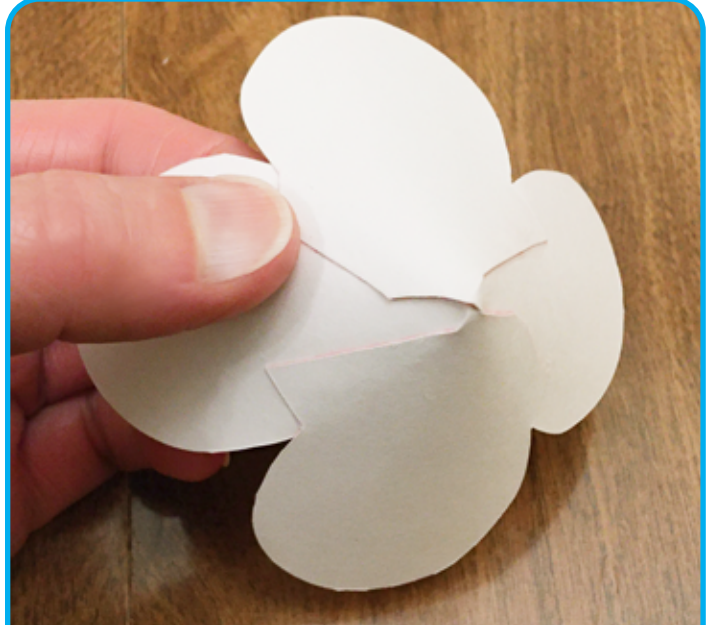
Step-by-Step Instructions (continued):

Petal layer 1 continued



Glue the tab on **Part B** to **Part C** to form a cone shape. Curl the petals using a pen/dowel.

4. Make petal layer 2 (two Part Cs)



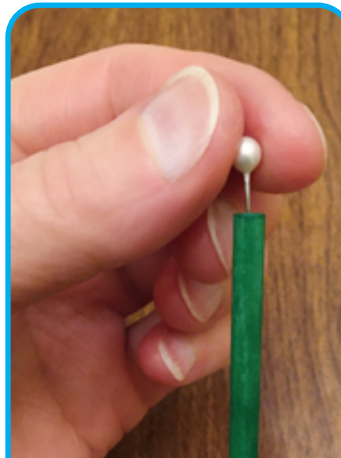
Glue together two **Part C** petals using the tabs as shown to form a cone shape. Then, curl the petals using a pen/dowel like Layer 1.

5. Make petal layer 3 (Part B & two Part Cs)



Glue together two of the **Part C** petals and one **Part B** using the tabs as shown to form a cone shape. Curl the petals like previous layers.

6. Prepare the stem



Use a green marker to color the dowel for the stem.

Push the pin into the end of the dowel rod to make a hole. This makes it easier to attach to the dowel.

7. Assemble the flower.



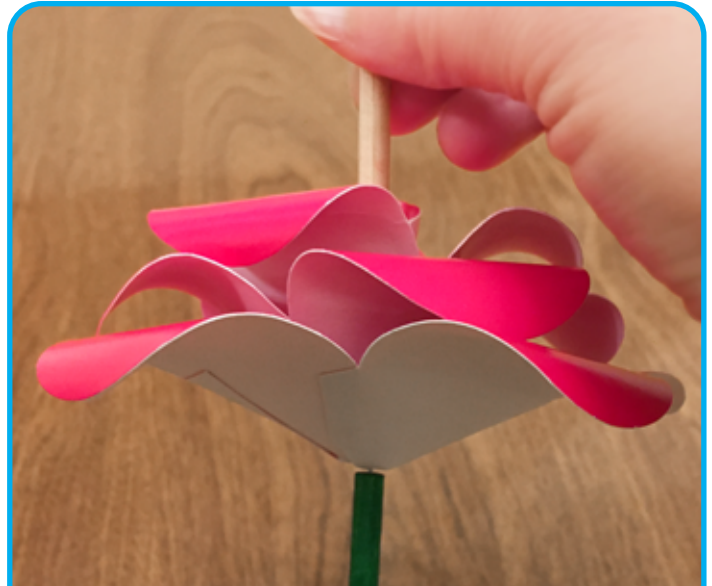
Pour glue on the small end of the center petal and drop the pin into the center with the point through the small hole.

Step-by-Step Instructions (continued):

Assemble the flower, continued



Place the center flower piece on top of petal Layer 1. Add a dab of glue where they meet. Push the pin through the center of Layer 1.



Add Layer 2 and then Layer 3 repeating these steps. Once all layers are together, carefully push the pin through the dowel using the guide hole you previously made.

8. Create the leaves



"Draw" veins on Part D leaves using the end of a dowel rod (or the back of a pen).

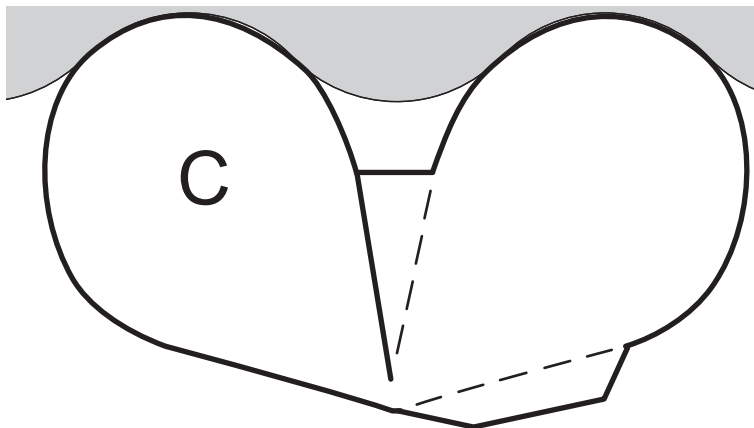
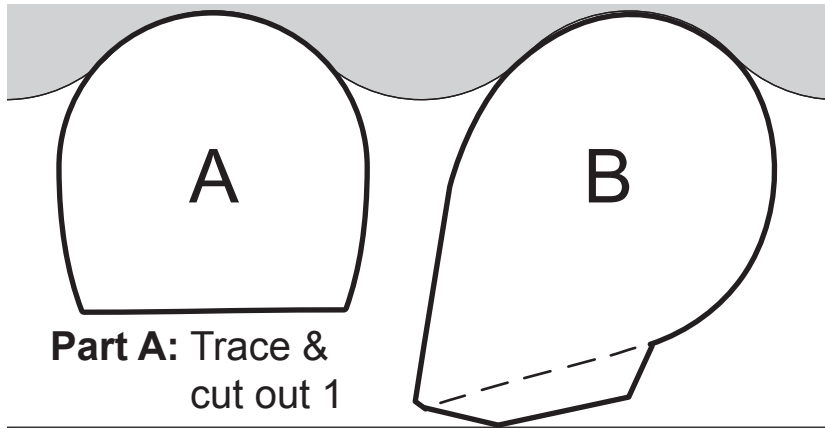


Bend leaves slightly to curl. Glue the leaves onto the stem.

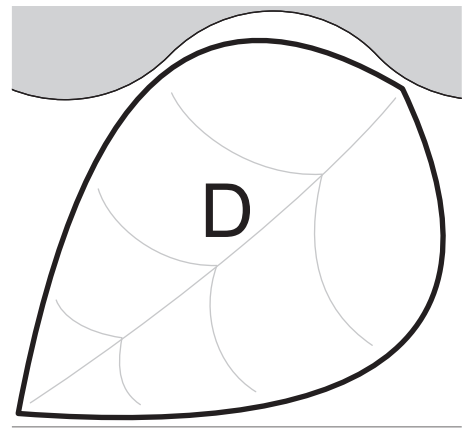


Use a variety of TREND solid and sparkle trimmers or borders to make one-of-a kind bouquets!

Part C: Trace & cut out 5



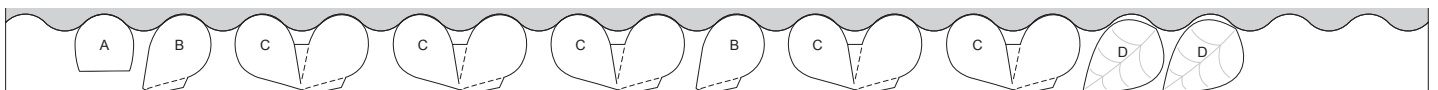
Part D: Trace & cut out 2

Part A is the the center of the flower.

1 **Part B** and 1 **Part C** make up petal Layer 1

2 **Part Cs** make up petal Layer 2

2 **Part Cs** and 1 **Part B** make up petal Layer 3



This is what **all** the flower pieces look like when laid out on one trimmer.
