Thanksgiving Dominoes Instructions:

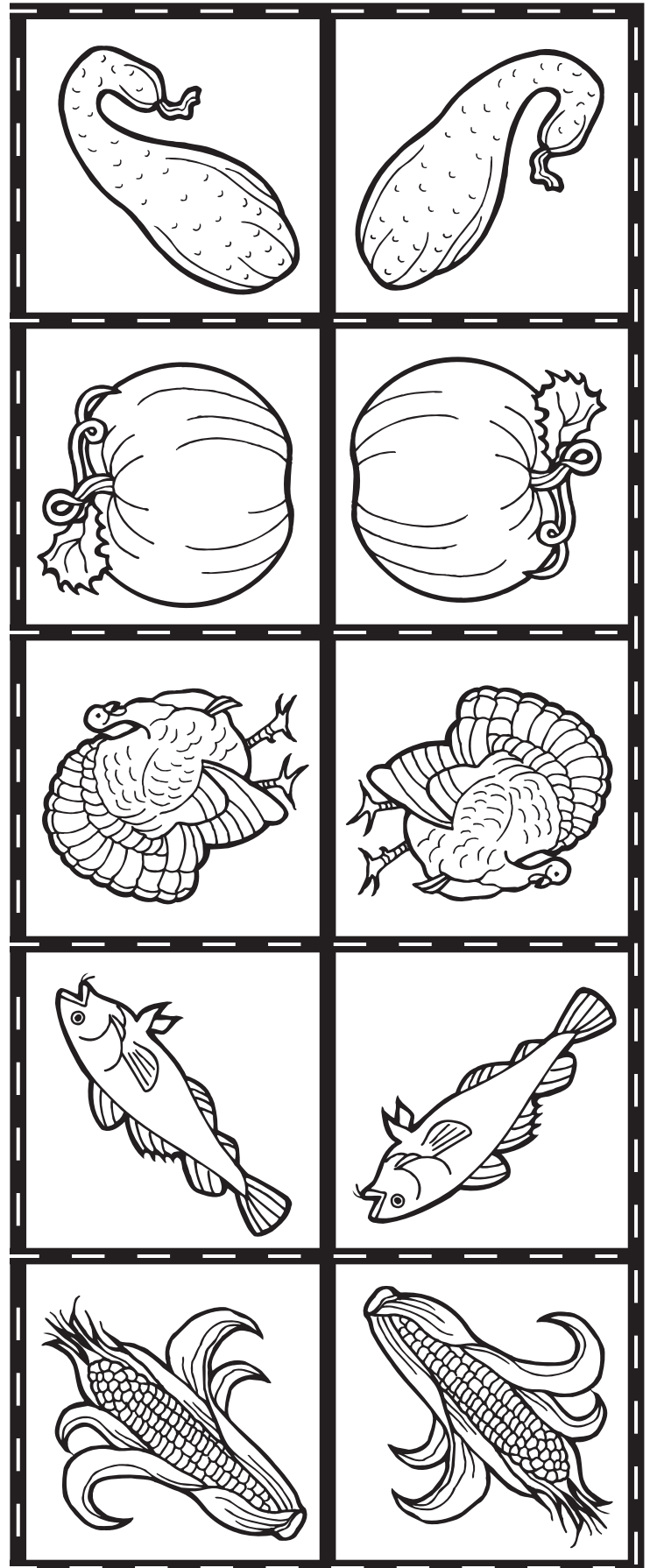
Cut out all 3 columns of dominoes. Glue onto poster/tag board to make the pieces extra sturdy. Color the game pieces using markers or crayons.

Cut pieces along dashed lines to create 15 separate dominoes. Make extra domino sets if playing with groups larger than 2 (do not duplicate doubles).



Quick-Play Rules:

- Lay the dominoes face down and mix them. This is the draw pile.
- Draw one domino from the pile and turn it face up. This is the start domino.
- Each player draws 5 dominoes and lays them face up.
- Choose a player to start.
- Find a match? Place the dominoes next to each other so the matching ends touch. Now it's the next player's turn.
- No match this time? Draw another domino from the pile. Found a match now? Play the new domino. Still no match? Keep the new domino, and let the next player take a turn.
- Dominoes that have matching pictures are called doubles. Play double dominoes by placing them crosswise against a matching domino end, making a T shape.
- Keep taking turns.
- Be the first to match all your dominoes and win!
