Make Cool-to-the-Touch Fake Snow

Materials

- 2 1/2 cups pure Baking Soda
- 1/2 cup White Hair Conditioner
- Large Bowl

Instructions

1. Add baking soda and white hair conditioner in a large bowl .
2. Mix ingredients together until completely combined

Notes

- If you need to make a larger batch of snow you should keep the ratios and multiply this recipe.
- Fake snow play can get messy, but easily sweeps/vacuums from floors. The play surface should be wiped clean after use and children should wash their hands.
- Small children may be tempted to put the snow in their mouths or rub their eyes. Please supervise children while playing with the pretend snow.
