Winding

The Gevril Five Points watch features a Swiss Made Mechanical Manual-Winding movement which can hold a 40 hour power reserve.

When using, the watch should be wound manually 30 clockwise turns with crown closed in position A.

After every 40 hours the watch will need to be wound manually again. It is easiest to wind the watch each day about 15 clockwise turns instead of waiting 40 hours.

Setting the Time

To set the time pull crown to position B and turn ONLY clockwise. Turning it counter-clockwise will cause damage to the movement.

Hours are indicated by the main center hand. The minutes are displayed on top by the retrograde feature. Seconds are displayed on the bottom sub dial.

After setting the time always make sure the crown is in position A to ensure water resistance.
