Mulberry Street is a principal thoroughfare in Manhattan in New York City. One of the great arteries of ethnic and cultural life and is closely associated with Italian-American culture and history. In the late 19th and early 20th centuries it was the heart of Manhattan's Little Italy.

The classic lines of the 41mm Mulberry Collection translate to the timeless design appeal of Italian styling with the interwoven dial displaying the see through between 5h and 6h showing the automatic Swiss movement. The double curved/domed sapphire crystal makes viewing the time with less optical distortion and actually stronger on any impact.

Winding

The Gevril Mulberry watch features a Swiss Made automatic mainspring movement which can hold a 40 hour power reserve.

For first time use watch should be wound manually 30 clockwise turns with crown closed in position A. The watch will then rewind itself automatically while being worn with regular hand movement.

If worn daily the watch can be left overnight without movement and will keep time. If the watch is left more then 30 hours without enough movement the watch will need to be wound manually again as in first time use.

Setting Time

To set the Time pull crown to position B and turn either direction.

After setting the time always make sure the crown is closed in position A to ensure water resistance.
