

- These cutting diagrams depict how to cut your pieces if the fabric has a directional print.
- Colors in cutting diagrams represent different cuts. Refer to the Nightingale Quilt Pattern for specific measurements.
- Note that there are two ways that you can cut a 1/4 yard for directional prints. The first method is the easiest, most straight-forward. The second is a little bit more technical, but it will render a larger piece of scrap fabric after cutting.
