
SAWTOOTH STAR BLOCK

UNFINISHED BLOCK SIZE 8½" x 8½" The Sawtooth Star is a versatile block that dates back to the 1800s. It is a traditional 8 point star made from flying geese and squares in a 9 patch format. This version uses 2 colors but you could also make a 3 color by adding a 3rd color for the center block, or a 4 color by adding a 4th color for the 4 corners.





flying geese




- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all (4) Color A $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares. Place (2) of the Color A $3\frac{1}{8}$ " squares right sides together on a Color B $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown.
- 2. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of the line and then cut on the line. Press seams open.




- 3. Place a Color A $3\frac{1}{8}$ " square right sides together with a unit from the previous step as shown. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of the line and cut on the line. Press seams open. Repeat Step 3 to make a total of (4) Flying Geese units.
- 4. **Trim units to measure 2½" x 4½"**. Click here for a trimming tutorial.

block construction



1. Sew rows together as shown above. To create nesting seams press the seams away from the flying geese in each row.



2. Sew rows together as shown above and press seams open. Unfinished block should measure 8½" x 8½".
