## Instructions for your Interchangeable Gnome

This Gingerbread set is sized for the 20" Interchangeable Gnome.

Please read carefully before you begin to make sure you understand how your gnome will be assembled. There will be pieces that you DO NOT GLUE.

I Paint all pieces of your gnome outfit in the colors of your choice. Shade/fleckle and add desired detail.

2° Before assembling, lay all pieces of your "outfit" together in this order... making sure all are lined up and "nested" together. "Layer I Hat/body- "Layer 2 Hat rim and beard. "Layer 3 Hat rim overlay and mustache. All pieces should nest together perfectly, and all three pieces of your hat should be lined up. After making sure everything is lined up, I like to work backwards, removing the mustache first, and gluing my hat rim overlay to the rim... then remove the beard and glue the hat rim to the hat, again making sure all of your hat pieces are lined up as you go. After your hat is fully assembled you are ready to "dress" your gnome.

3" Use Velcro or glue dots to attach your body overlay to your main gnome body. DO NOT GLUE, as your body is part of your main kit.

4° Add Velcro or glue dots to the back of your assembled hat and line it up and secure both to the main body. ° Make sure you are using the same material to attach hat and body so they line up and nest together.

5° slide your beard up up to meet the hat rim, moving it until you find it's "nesting place". Secure your beard to the body overlay with glue dots or velcro, but DO NOT GLUE. (your beard is part of your main kit)

6° Lay your mustache into the cutout area where it should nest perfectly in place, covering any other seams. Secure with a small piece of velcro or glue dot. DO NOT GLUE, as your mustache/nose is part of your main kit.

7° arrange all of your accent pieces to your outfit. Glue pieces to the hat, shoes, etc. but do not glue to the beard. Instead, use velcro or glue dots. Use velcro or glue dots to attach your shoes. DO NOT GLUE. you will get a new pair with most kits.
