






BEFORE YOU START




- 1. With the "Groove" facing the "Notch", push Tab into Slot until it "pops" in place.
- 2. Apply force on part to secure.




Push tabs on Toe (a) into slots on Bottom Shelf (b). Tabs and slots must be lined up correctly or they will not properly tighten.




Turning the part upright push down on Toe (a) until the ends are flush with the ends of Bottom Shelf (b).




Pop the tabs on Top Shelf (a) and Bottom Shelf (b) into corresponding slots on Left Side (b), as shown. Left Side (c) slots will not be visible if Shelves are installed correctly. A second adult is needed to hold shelves in place.




Insert Back tabs into matching slots in Side . A Full Back comes as one piece. A Split Full Back comes in two pieces that share the middle slot when inserted.




As one adult holds the back and shelves steady, insert bottom slots on Right Side (a) into the tabs on Bottom Shelf (b).




With the help of a second person, insert tabs on Back and Top into slots in Side .



Carefully tip shelving unit onto its back on a hard floor and press down on ends of Bottom (3) and Top (4) until flush with Sides (5) and (5) to tighten.



Carefully set shelving unit upright. Insert Pins into holes at the desired height and rest Shelf on pins.
