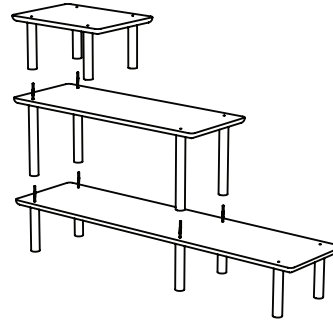
**!** Be sure that you are always screwing the legs up into the bottom of the shelf.



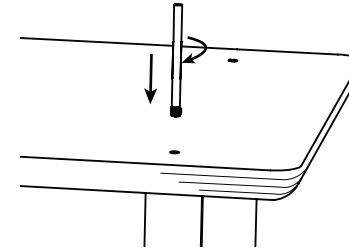
**1** Legs are screwed tightly into the underside of the shelves



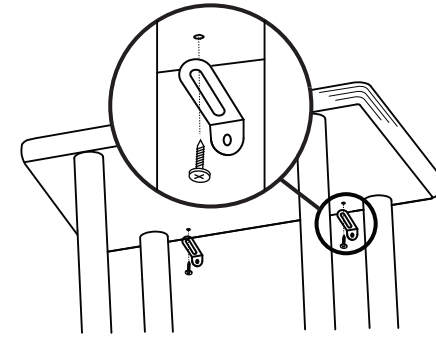
**3** Shelves are securely stacked by placing legs over Stabilizer Pins, and pressing down until flush.



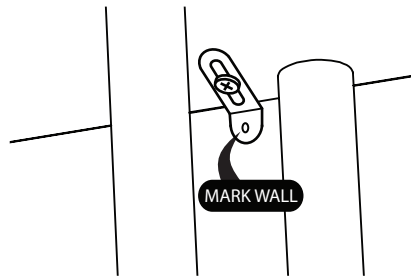
**4** Stack shelves according to your desired configuration to create your shelving unit.



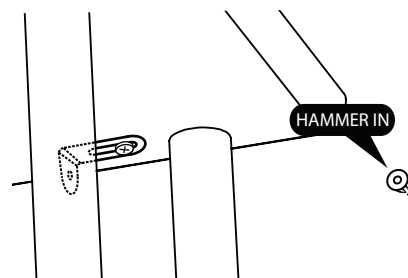
**2** Stabilizer Pins are screwed into the tops of lower shelves.



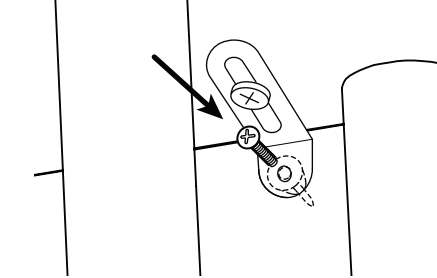
**5** To anchor to the wall, thread the short screw through the long slot on the bracket into the two pilot holes underneath the top shelf.



**6** Next, push the bracket flush against the wall, and mark the wall through the hole. Do this with both brackets.



**7** Move the brackets and shelf out of the way, then use a hammer to pound Wallclaw Drywall Anchor into the wall at the two marked points.



**8** Move the shelf back against the wall, position the brackets against the Wallclaw Drywall Anchors, then screw in Long Screw until tight.
