




The number of Shelves (4), Legs (3), and Stabilizer Pins (6) vary depending on ordered unit. You may have extra parts according to your design choice.


BEFORE YOU START

Be sure that you are always screwing the legs up into the bottom of the shelf.




ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Legs 3 are screwed tightly into the underside of the Shelves 4.




Stabilizer Pins are screwed into at least two corners of tops of lower Shelves .




Shelves **(a)** are securely stacked by placing Legs **(3)** over Stabilizer Pins **(e)** and pressing down until flush.




Stack Shelves **(A)** according to your desired configuration to create your shelving unit.



To anchor to the wall, thread the Short Screw **(C)** through the long slot on the Bracket **(E)** into the two pilot holes underneath the top Shelf **(A)**.



Push the Bracket flush against the wall and mark the wall through the hole. Do this with both brackets.



Move the unit out of the way then use a hammer to pound the Wallclaw Drywall Anchor (1) into the wall at the two marked points.



Move the shelf back against the wall and position the Brackets (against the Wallclaw Drywall Anchors (b), then screw in Long Screw (against the Wallclaw Drywall Long Screw (b) until tight.


