What to do?



Some of the sumptuous delicacies that you must try while in Argentina are Asado (being the national dish of the country Asado also refers to barbecue and includes beef, pork, ribs, sausages and more), Choripán (looks more like a hot dog with pork and beef chorizo grilled over wood flames and garnished with chimichurri), Dulce de leche (obtained from the milk of cows, condensed and cooked till it becomes sticky and sweetened) and Chimichurri (the country's popular condiments that include chopped parsley, oregano, onion, garlic, chilli pepper flakes, olive oil and a touch of acid, like lemon or vinegar).

What to wear?




TOP CELEBRITY MEN'S UNDERWEAR MODELS




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
