



2 Rilby Cocoon chair by GamFratesi for Dedon
 Tasked with creating a cocoon canopy that felt secluded yet airy, Copenhagen design studio GamFratesi fashioned maritime rope in a vertically parallel pattern to let in light, while the faceted frame allows for some privacy.

3 Acacia dining table by Holly Hunt
 Part of Holly Hunt's second outdoor furniture launch, the table draws inspiration for its wide (66 inches in diameter, to be exact) glass top from the shade-granting tree of the same name.

4 Olympus woven bar chair by Sutherland
 Perennials provides the high-performance acrylic rope that's woven along the curved back of Sutherland's new bar chair style.
