BEAUTIFUL KITCHENS FOR EVERYDAY LIVING



THE LIVING ROOM'S custom sofa (ABOVE) is covered in a Perennials linen, a no-fuss stain-resistant fabric. "We didn't want Lisa to worry about spills," says Austin. A symmetrical display of antique prints of birds' nests brings order to the room. Austin selected the antique lyre-back chair and forged-iron coffee table "because you can see through them," he says. "They make the room feel more open." In the foyer (LEFT), the blue palette is picked up in the rug from Landry & Arcari, the tole planters, and the painting, *Looking Glass Falls* by Linda Gritta. A trumeau mirror from the 1800s mimics the architecture of the door frames while the antique Italian gilded chandelier coordinates with the dining room sconces.
