Forget the notion of new beginnings. **Sutherland's** spring collections are all about celebrating the past. "We are bringing a classic perspective to our modern designs," says David Sutherland, CEO of Perennials and Sutherland. The company's latest outdoor furnishings include Versailles, a pair of French baroque-style dining tables by Joe Doyle for John Hutton, as well as Sag Harbor, a woven lounge chair inspired by a 1950s chair designed by Francis Mair. Fear not: The slender chair only appears delicate. Its aluminum frame and woven wrap are weatherproof, so it's ideal for extended outdoor use. There's also the eight-piece Franck Collection designed by Vincent Van Duysen. Inspired by French interior designer Jean-Michel Frank, the collection includes chairs, tables, a sofa and a chaise. Van Duysen is known for his functional and minimalist approach, and the AD100-recognized and 2017 FX International Interior Design Award winner's signature Belgian Bluestone appears throughout the Sutherland collaboration.
