

ENGINE STABILIZER COVER

Parts Included:

1 Engine Stabilizer Cover

Installation Instructions:

- 1. Park on a level surface and shut off the motorcycle. Ensure that the engine has had time to cool before installation.
- 2. Use an ammonia-based cleaner to remove any contaminants on the stabilizer. A clean surface is necessary to ensure a strong bond between the cover and stabilizer.
- 3. Test fit cover against stabilizer for proper placement.
- 4. Activate adhesive by rubbing with fingernail, then remove adhesive backing. Press and hold cover firmly in place for 60 seconds. Adhesive fully cures within 24 hours.
