- Control Probe If cleaning is necessary, wipe over with a damp cloth. NEVER IMMERSE THE CONTROL PROBE IN ANY LIQUIDS. Always ensure that the probe is completely dry before inserting it into the socket.
- Pan-Wash The inside surface of the pan in hot soapy water, using a sponge or soft cloth. Do not use any harsh abrasive cleaners. Normal dish washing liquid should be sufficient. Rinse and dry thoroughly, try not to get any water into the socket but if by chance this happens, always ensure the socket is completely dry before inserting the control probe.
- Glass lid Wash the lid in warm soapy water using a soft sponge, rinse and dry thoroughly.
