

## Shared Reading Lesson Plan, Grades 2/3

Title/Instructional Focus: .

STEPS	PROCEDURES
Introduce the Text	<ol> <li>Share your screen and display the cover. Read the title and the author's name. Encourage predictions and connections.</li> <li>Provide a brief book introduction.</li> </ol>

Read the Text	Invite students to read the book with you. Point to the words as you read. Plan specific places in the text to engage students in echo, choral, or cloze reading (pages).  Plan several stopping points to ask a question and engage students in a brief discussion.  Page:
