FROZEN SPECIMENS

Upon receipt your frozen specimen is likely to have defrosted. Specimens can then be re-frozen for dissection at a later date (use within 2 years) or kept refrigerated if required immediately (within 2 days).



Allow 24 hours for specimen to fully defrost before dissection.

No chemicals are used in Darwin's frozen specimens, this means that they do not have the same chemical odour of their embalmed counterparts and retain their colour well. Consequently, they are safer for students to handle and gloves are not required. Although please note that rats and mice may have sharp claws!

Darwin's frozen specimens are not suitable for human consumption.
