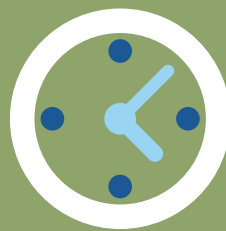

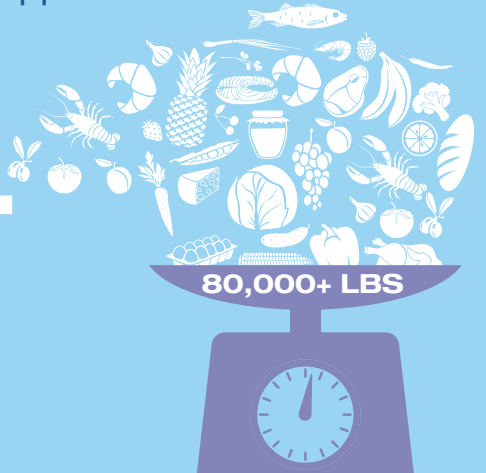

# SENIORS THE RIPPLE EFFECT

**1,591** seniors live at 14 senior properties in 11 cities with an average age of **77**

**25%** qualify for a skilled nursing facility but live independently with our wrap-around support and services

**80,000+** pounds of healthy food delivered to seniors in 2014
