HOUSEHOLDS SERVED

177 Chronically Homeless households were provided housing and services

INDIVIDUALS SERVED

209 individuals

200 adults
9 children

55% Male
45% Female

50 Seniors (62+)
10 Veterans
75 History Domestic Violence

HOUSING RETENTION RATE

92% of households have exited to or remain in permanent housing

INCOME INCREASES

62% of adults in the program gained or increased their income over the course of the year

PRIOR LIVING SITUATION

64% entered from place not meant from human habitation
31% entered from emergency shelter
4% transferred from another PSH project
1% entered from psychiatric hospital

HEALTH CONDITIONS

67% of participants have mental health issues
23% of participants have substance abuse issues
63% of participants have chronic health conditions
5% of participants have HIV/AIDS
27% of participants have developmental disabilities
63% of participants have physical disabilities

52% of participants have 3+ conditions
