

Diamonds are forever, and this quilt is sure to be a family heirloom!

It is a celebration of a classic sampler quilt but with a modern twist. Designed through the artful arrangement of half-square triangles, our quilt forms a stunning parade of diamonds that gracefully dance around a center medallion. The use of half-square triangles makes this pattern enjoyable for all skill levels. At the same time, the quilt's focal point, the center medallion, serves as a striking center from which the diamonds radiate.

Block of the Month begins Tuesday, January 16 or Saturday, January 20 and meets the third Saturday (9-5) or the third Tuesday (9-6) each month.



This beautiful geometric quilt is made with 60 degree triangles cut with an easy-to-use triangle ruler. Mike has many helpful tips for efficiency and construction - you'll wonder why you didn't start this project earlier!

The remainder of the oars and background are typical sewing. This pattern is by Quilt Fox Design.

It's your choice which one you'll make and Mike will teach how to sew a bargello quilt with no seam-to-seam matching. All you need is straight line beginner sewing to make these stunning half-drop bargello quilts.


