


Single, King Single, Single Double & King Single Queen




Single/King Single; Place Slats onto Side Rails. Align with one end of side cleat & fasten through hole provided. Stretch to align other end of side cleat & secure remaining screws.

Double/Queen; Place Slats onto Side Rails. Align with one end of side cleat & fasten through hole provided. Repeat opposite end with second slat. Stretch both to create middle gap between 50-95mm & secure.



Place Safety Rail inside Frame, align with top of post & fasten.
Centre Safety Spacer Rail between Safety Rail & Side Rail then fasten.
Repeat on opposite side.

### The Important Stuff.

Tighten all bolts after one month of use.

All beds should be checked periodically to ensure fasteners are tight.

In rooms with ceiling fans care must be taken to ensure distance between closest point is at least 2m.

Children should be discouraged from playing on bunks.

Upper bunk not suitable for children under the age of six.
