

Salicylic Acid Exfoliators/Peels

Patch-Test Before Using On Entire Face:

Patch-test below the ear, per the directions below. Wait 24-48 hours to see if any irritation develops.

Directions for Use:

- Have a kitchen timer handy
- Apply this product to cleansed, dry skin
- Squeeze a small amount of Salicylic Acid Serum onto fingertips and apply to facial area
- A thin layer is all that is necessary
- Set your kitchen timer and leave serum on the skin for 1 minute
- Rinse with luke-warm, soapy water
- Rinse a second time to ensure *all* of the acid has been removed from the skin. Then pat dry
- Follow with our Aloe w/Lavendar for post-peel calming
- Do *not* use products containing acids for at least 24-48 hours post-peel
- Rinse thoroughly with cool, soapy water
- Use sunscreen with an SFP of 15 or higher for 1 week post-peel

This product should be used every 7-10 days *only.*

More frequent usage could result in irritation or burns.

Visible peeling may not result, but deep exfoliation will be achieved, along with oil control when used as directed.

You may increase the amount of time you leave this peel on the skin in 30 second increments, up to a 3-4 minute level. Never leave this product on the skin longer than 4 minutes. Burning could result. Less-is-best with acids. If you are achieving good results at the 1-minute level, there is no need to leave it on the skin longer.
