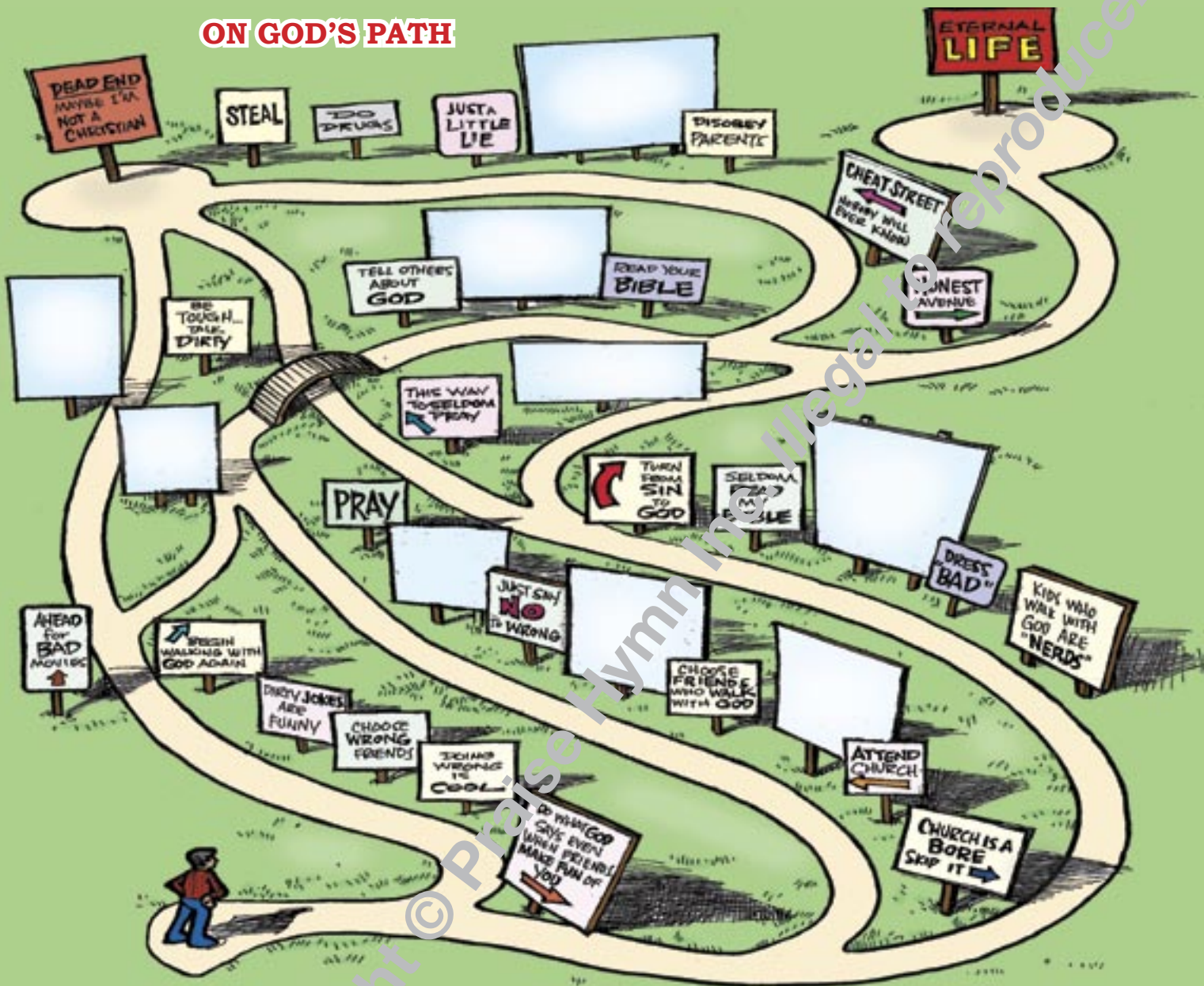

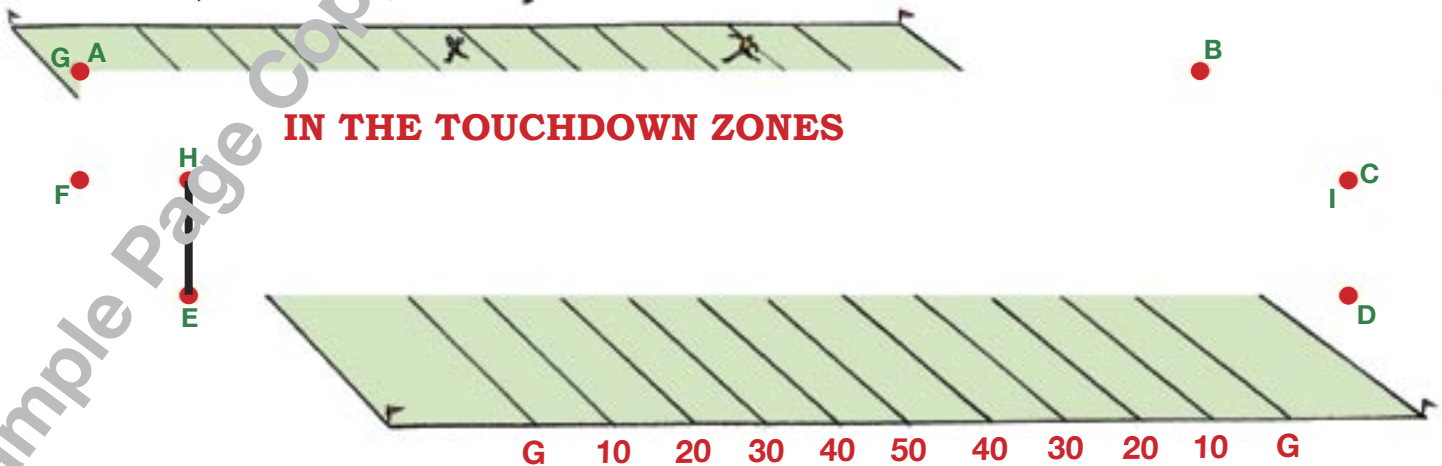

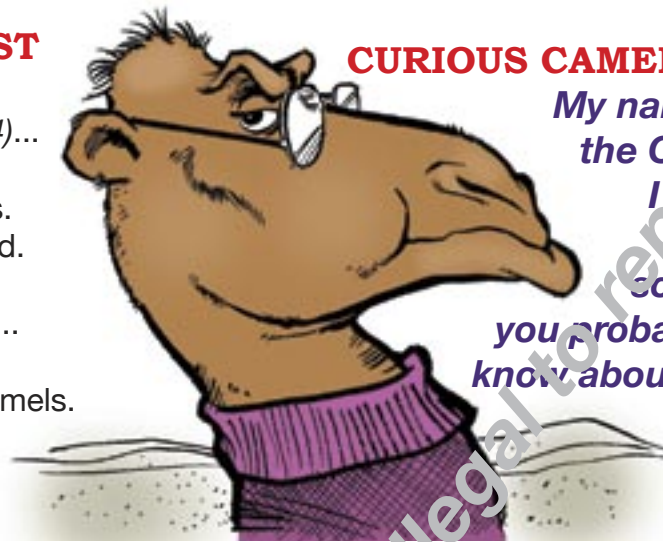

*So what do all these curious camel quirks have to do with Bible? Well, I'll tell you...*

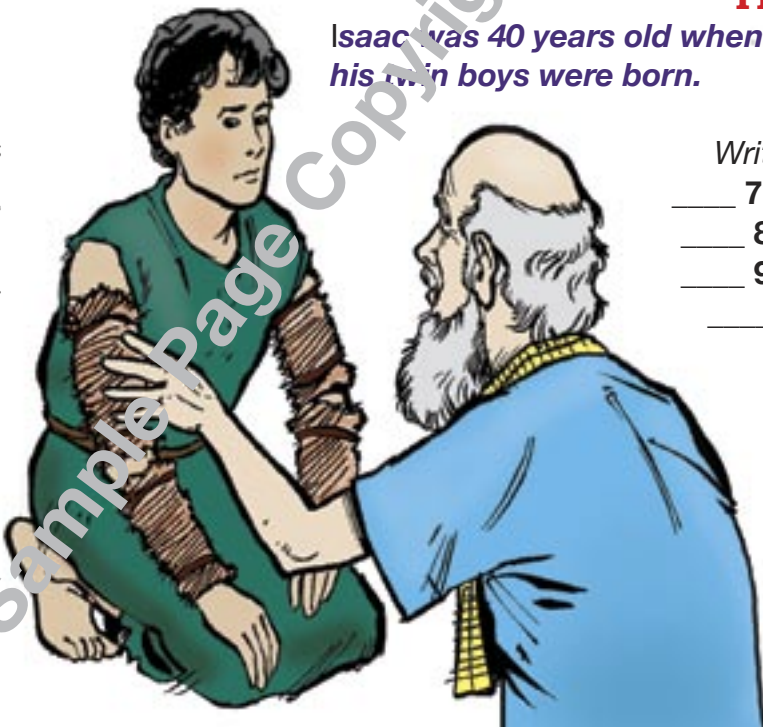

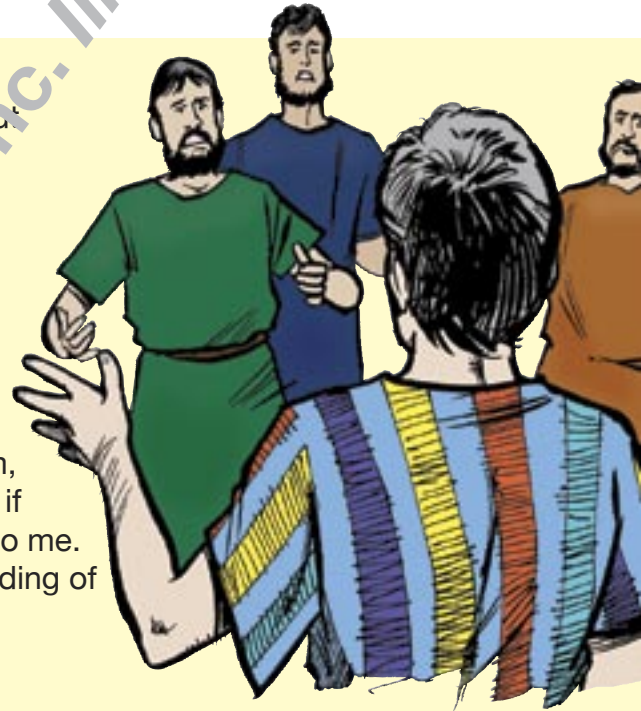
## CONFUSE US

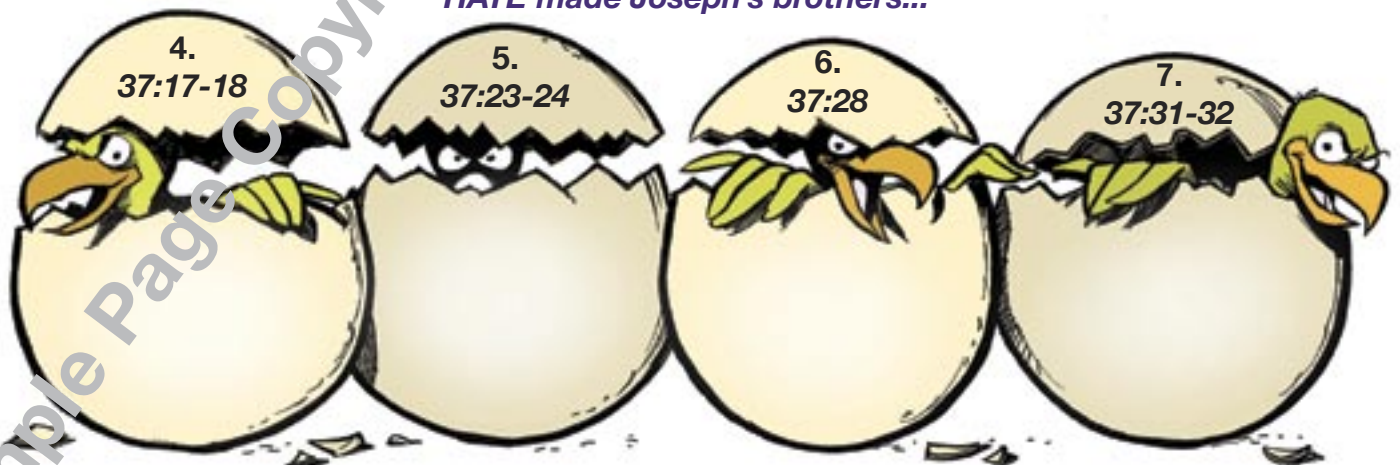
## JUST A DAYDREAMER?

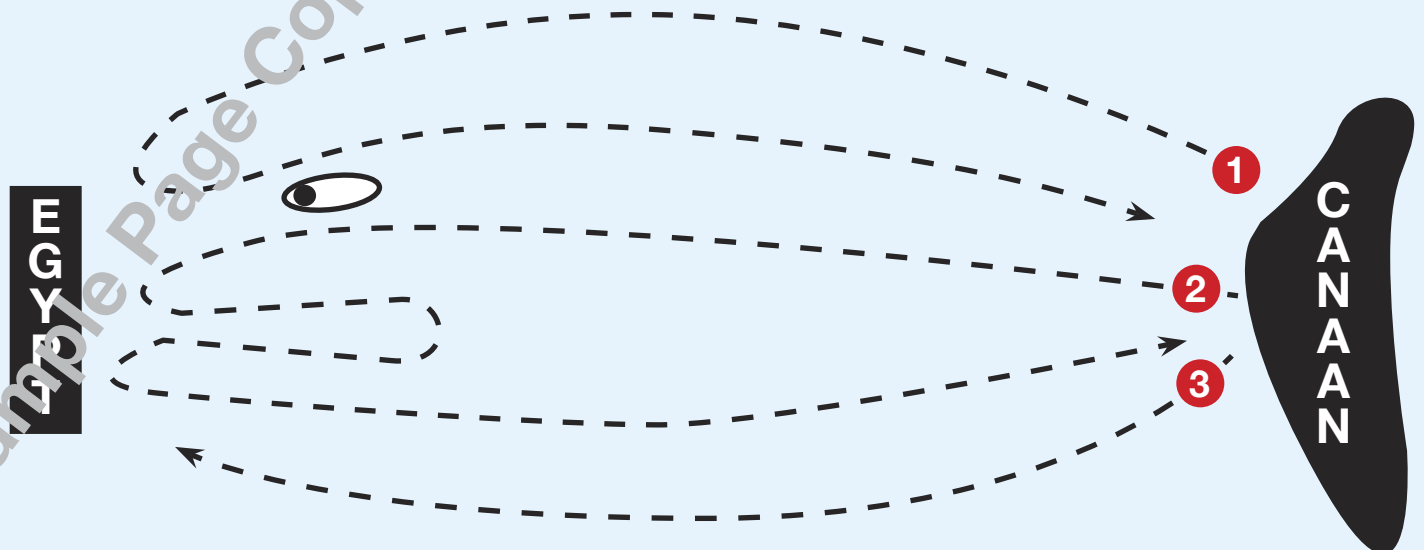
**18. JOSEPH** (45:3-5 and 13).
