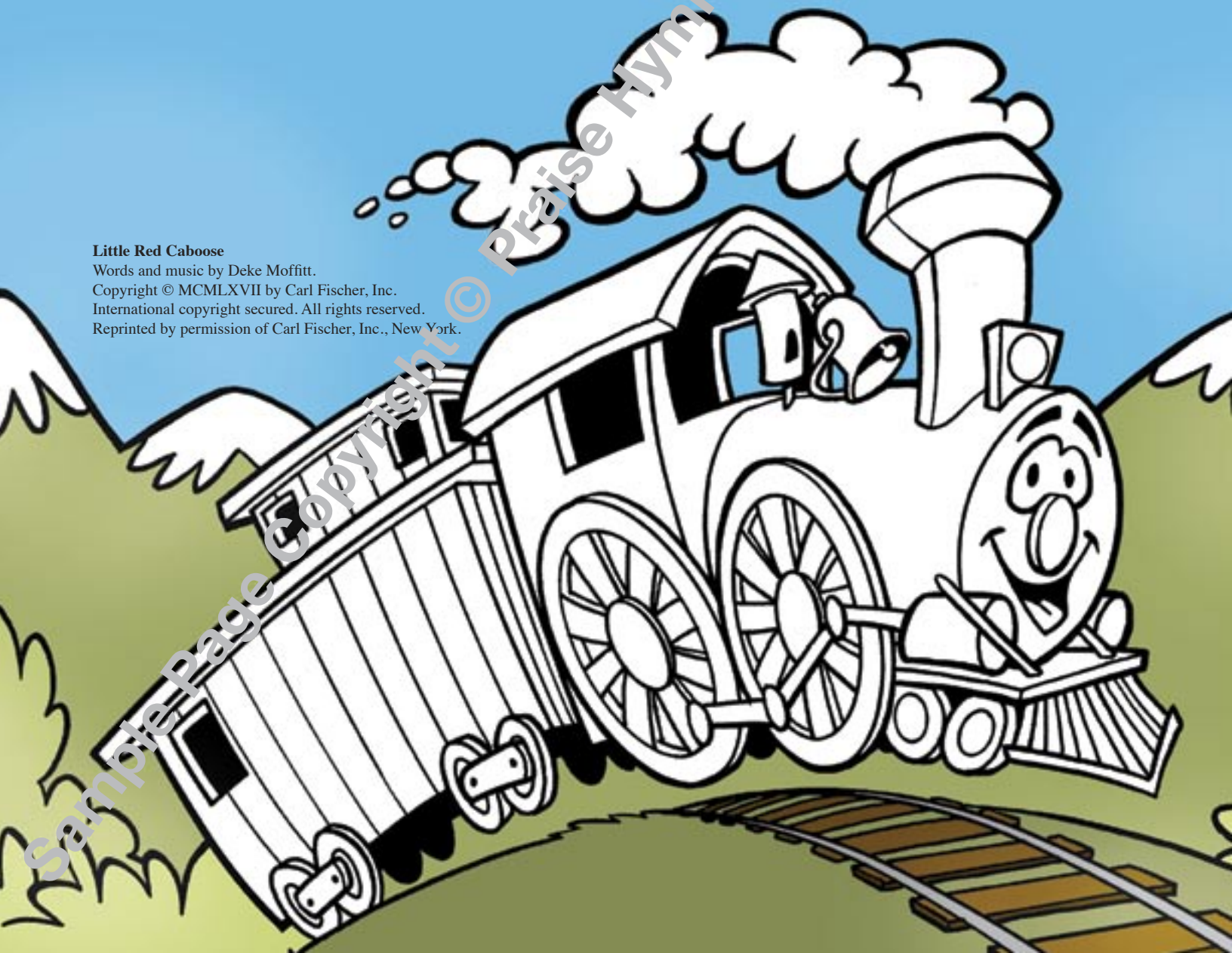

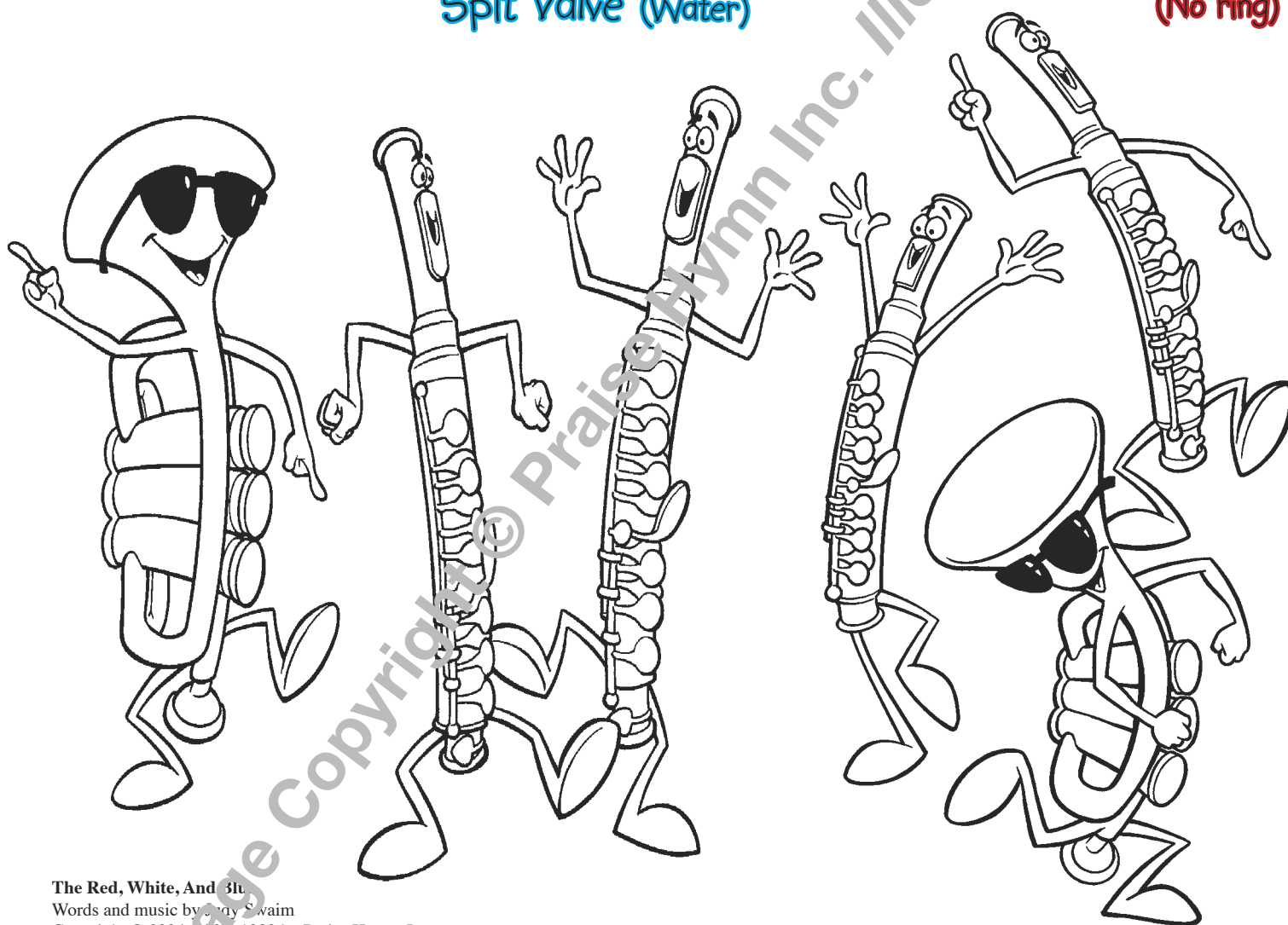

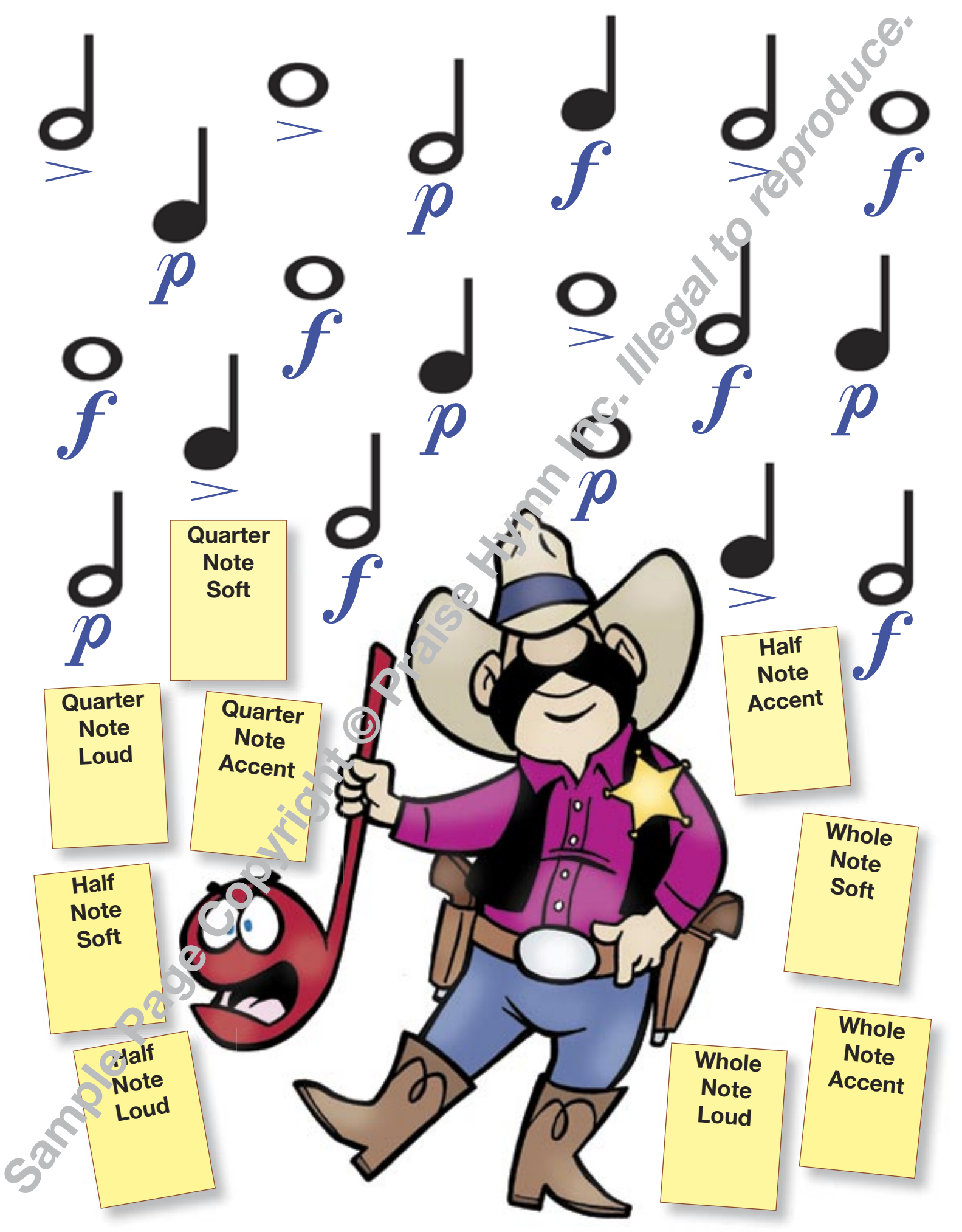


The Red, White, And Blue
