What to do in an emergency situation. Also have a map of where to meet and what locations accept animals in your area.



keep all your kit items in one place.

FOOD & WATER

At least 3-7 days worth per pet.

MEDICATIONS

A few days worth packed & labeled with dosage, strength, and what its for.

ID TAGS

Keep these updated with you & your pets info.

PET FIRST AID KIT

Make your own or find it preassembled online/local pet store.

LIST OF EMERGENCY #'s

Include your Vet, emergency contacts, microchip number, any other medical information.

PET PHOTO

Have a physical print out photo of your pets.



BASIC CARE ITEMS

Wet Wipes / Sanitizer / Flashlight & extra batteries / Garbage Bags / Paper Towels / Extra Poopbag Rolls



TO-GO BOWL

Have 1 or 2 bowls on hand that collapse & can hold food & water.



TREATS & TREAT POUCH

A bag of your pets favorite treats in an easy to access treat pouch.

EXTRA GEAR

A backup set of a leash, collar or harness, and a soft muzzle for pups who get anxious.

COMFORT ITEM

A toy or item with your scent to keep pup calm

Crate / Carrier

Good for pups who get spooked easily. Mark pets name and your contact info clearly on the crate/carrier.

Blankets & Seasonal Gear

Prepare any gear for the season and weather that are relevant to your area.
