INTRODUCTION

Congratulations on the purchase of your new BYK bicycle. To help you get the most enjoyment and performance out of your BYK, we have prepared this manual as your guide to its proper use and maintenance. We encourage you to read it carefully and completely before riding your bicycle for the first time, paying special attention to the cautions for your own personal safety. While you will find this manual full of helpful and informative advice, it is not meant to be a comprehensive instruction on the workings and assembly of a bicycle. If you are interested in learning more about your bicycle, then you should read one of the many excellent books available on bicycle repair and maintenance. Your local bicycle shop is also a good source of information.

Some bicycle adjustments and maintenance procedures, especially those involving brakes, chain tension and all bearings, do require knowledge, experience and mechanical ability. For your own protection, we continually warn you throughout this manual against making any adjustments to your bicycle that are beyond your ability. If your bicycle develops a problem, or if you are unsure of how to properly maintain it, take it to your BYK bicycle dealer. Your dealer is a professional bicycle mechanic and has the correct tools for making adjustments.

Assembly instructions are no included in this owners manual as your BYK bicycle should come to you completely assembled and properly adjusted. It is your right to receive it in this condition.

It is not possible to illustrate and describe in this manual all the different component brands that come with your BYK bicycle. However, we have carefully selected those component models that best represent that type of component. If you should have any questions concerning the particular components on your bicycle, your BYK dealer will be happy to answer them for you.

Enjoy your BYK and if you should have nay problems, comments or questions, do not hesitate to contact your friendly BYK dealer.

WARNINGS

Before you ride, be sure you familiarise yourself with all of the following safeguards. Failure to follow these warnings could result in serious injury to yourself or others and damage to your bicycle.

- Read this manual carefully and completely, paying particular attention to the cautions.
- Be sure the bicycle fits the intended user.
- Check that your bicycle is in proper operating condition. Special attention should be paid to brakes, chain tension, wheels and tyres and all nuts and bolts.
- Be sure you understand how to operate your bicycle and its controls.
- Always wear a helmet while riding
- Wear bright or light coloured clothing or a vest with reflectors so that you can easily be seen.
- Know and obey traffic laws. Your bicycle is a vehicle and subject to the same rules as motor vehicles.
- Always ride single file and with the traffic, never against it.
- Maintain a steady course. Do not weave in and out of the traffic or make a sudden swerve.
- Exercise caution when making tight turns. You could fall if your foot catches in the front wheel.
- Use proper hand signals to warn others road users, other cyclists and pedestrians of your intention to stop or turn.
- Never carry riders or packages which may inhibit your control of the bicycle or obstruct your view.
- Do not stunt ride or hitch a free ride on a truck or car.
- Remember braking distances increase in wet conditions. Ride more slowly, be alert, and apply your brakes sooner than you would under dry conditions.
- Always ride defensively. Watch for car entering traffic or doors of parked cars
 opening. Beware of common road hazards such as broken glass, storm drains, pot
 holes, pedestrians, dogs and cats, and railroad crossings.
- Never ride at night without reflectors and a proper lighting system.
- Do not tamper with or physically alter your bicycle frame in any way. If you fail to
 observe this warning you ay seriously harm the structural integrity and/or longevity of
 your frame which could lead to a serious accident. The guarantee on your frame will
 also be voided if the frames has been tampered with or altered.

OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY

Not all repairs, adjustments and replacements are the result of defects in materials or workmanship.

There are other circumstances beyond the control of the manufacturer that might make a visit to your authorised BYK dealer necessary. They would include weather and atmospheric conditions, varying road surfaces, bicycle usage and individual riding habits.

Some owners misuse their bicycles by subjecting them to abnormal stresses, such as competing in sanctioned and unsanctioned competitive events, stunt riding, installation of inferior replacement parts or lubricants, improper repairs or modifications that affect the bicycles reliability or overall performance.

DETERIORATION DUE TO USE AND EXPOSURE

Painted and electro plated surfaces which have become affected by dents, nicks, scratches, stone chipping, tree sap, salt, chlorine, fertilizer, perspiration, atmospheric conditions and industrial fall out which occurs after the delivery of the bicycle, and normal deterioration due to exposure to environmental conditions are the owners responsibility.

BYK LIMITED WARRANTY

BYK built bicycle and components are warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship.

LIMITED WARRANTY BYK frames and forks are warranted against defects arising from normal use for 10 years from the date of purchase.

All other BYK components are warranted against failure or defect arising from normal uses for 1 year from the date of purchase. Tyres, tubes, brakes shoes, cable and training wheels are excluded from this warranty. Shipping and labour charges are not included in this warranty.

BYK will replace or repair at their discretion any frame found to be defective in materials or workmanship. Replacement will be made with frames of current design that may not be exact duplicates of originally purchased goods. The frame model used for replacement will not be lower in value than the original frame.

This warranty gives you specific rights in addition to other rights you may have. These rights vary from state to state. Which the consumer has under the trade practices act and other state territory laws.

EXCLUSIONS The warranty, or any implied warranty, does not cover normal wear and tear and all warranties are void if the bicycle is used for other than normal activities. Occasionally bicycles are involved in accidents. Repairs or replacements required where there is evidence that such conditions have contributed to a component failure, will not covered by this warranty.

NOTICE The user assumes all risks for any personal injuries, damages to or failure of the bicycle and other losses if this BYK bicycle is used in any competitive event, including, but not limited to, bicycle racing, dirt biking or similar activities, or training for such activities, or with motors or power-driven vehicles. This warranty does not cover any personal injuries, damage to or failure of the bicycle or any other losses due to accident, misuse, neglect, abuse, normal wear, improper assembly or improper maintenance.

HELMETS The BYK organisation advises you must wear an A.S. approved bicycling helmet when bicycling.

See Your Authorised BYK dealer for Service and Replacement

Claims under this warranty should be made to your authorised BYK dealer with dated proof of purchase, and said dealer will determine if the components(s) is defective. Any defective part will be replaced free of charge. Installation labour is not included in this warranty. This warranty is extended to the original owner only and does not cover any defect, malfunction or failure which does not conform to the limited warranty aforesaid.
