## Directions

Clogged drains:

Initial Treatment - Pour 2 ounces into clogged drain. Let drain sit undisturbed for at least 6 hours. Repeat if required.

Maintenance Treatment - One ounce weekly or 2-3 ounces for drains that receive large amounts of organic matter (kitchen and garbage disposals)

Do not use bleach, harsh detergents or disinfectants in conjunction with this product.
