

We are lucky in New Zealand to have many avenues available to us for funding. Funding and grants are only available to community groups or not for profit organisations where the greater community may benefit. There are 3 main stages of a funding application

- 1. Identify the need
- 2. Identify the aim and outcomes
- 3. Implementation

The starting point for any project is to be clear on the need it is addressing. What is the problem, issue, or situation where something needs to change to make things better? Is it benefiting for a person, a group of people, or an organisation?

The aim describes the purpose of the project and the outcome is the desired result.

You will also need to state the steps in which you will achieve your goals. How will it be implemented?

For example where will the Defib be located, will it be available to the public? How will you train members to use it. How will you budget for replacement parts if needed? The more information you include in your application, the better your chance.

Find below a list of reputable funding providers in New Zealand. The application process can be a little time consuming but if you do receive funding the benefits to you and your community greatly outweigh the brief time commitment.
