



A built-in direct external air supply inlet is standard and there is one discreet user-friendly slider control to provide the perfect blend of combustion air which will ensure an ultra-clean burn throughout the whole burn cycle, as well as keep the clear glass. There's a larger than average window and the subtle F-Type detailing on the cast iron door is carried through to the low cast iron-fronted plinth to create a seamless contemporary design.


