MATERIALS AND TOOLS NEEDED


Wrench or pliers, rags, thread seal tape

When using a wrench or pliers, always protect the finish by wrapping parts with a cloth


HOW TO INSTALL:


- 1. Remove the existing shower head before installing the new shower arm.
- 2. Remove the old flange by using a screwdriver to carefully pry it away from the ceiling, and remove the old arm if there is one. (See fig. 1.)
- 3. Wrap the thread seal tape 4-5 times around the threads on one end of the arm in a clockwise direction. (See fig. 2.)
- 4. Screw the taped end of the shower arm into the plumbing connection inside of the ceiling and tighten it by hand at first, then wrap a cloth around the arm and use a wrench to tighten it more. This will prevent damage to the finish. (See fig. 3 & 4.)
- 5. Slide the new flange onto the arm and push it against the ceiling. (See fig. 5.)
- 6. Install showerhead according to manufacturer's instructions.


