To make the story even sweeter, Simply Enchanted is sired by the most popular bull in our lineup, Good Times.

The stars have aligned for this one to be a great one, and it gets better—the DNA came back clean, **she is a Maine Angus!** Simply Enchanted is special. The way she is designed is wild, her neck is like a giraffe and ties in as high as you can make one. Her maternal look and structure are incredible, her center body is so bold and sweeping, and her angles and hind leg are what dreams are made of. Stout pinned, wide structured and powerful everywhere. Show the wheels off this one and then take her straight to the donor pen. Her generating potential is unlimited!

Simply Enchanted will continue the legacy of the coveted Classic Lot 1!

Late last spring I convinced John we needed to flush some of our best cows to Good Times, and 474F was at the top of the list. She may be John's favorite Maine donor that we own, and that could partially be due to how she is bred. Sired by the great Maternal Made and backed by the legendary full sister to Cerveza, how could you not love her? She is one of the best Maternal Made daughters you will ever see—stout featured, huge hipped and choked necked, all the makings of a great donor.

This was one of 474F's first sets of ET calves, and they did not disappoint. After a lot of thought, we decided to offer all four sisters. All four are different in how they are constructed, but they all have one thing in common—they are just flat out good cattle. It is no secret that Good Times has been knocking it out of the park in the Angus ring; however, he is just as good if not better when you cross him up! These four sisters are all wildly good looking with a tight throat latch and virtually no chest. Lots 2 and 3 are the stouter featured, wider constructed, heavier structured sisters, while Lots 4 and 5 are more refined, flatter and more maternal in their look. All four are sound structured, functional kind of females that have a bright future. Study them hard sale day!
