



NEW SCREENING QUESTIONS FOR COVID-19

Naandwechige-Gamig Wikwemikong Health Centre, in collaboration with partnering Manitoulin Island health care organizations, are using the following questions to assist in determining risk to exposure to COVID-19.

These questions have changed somewhat, as per Public Health guidelines.

These questions are being asked by WHC staff when someone calls the main line to book appointments or if someone comes through the entrance of the WHC.

Do you have any of the following new symptoms?

(Fever, cough, or shortness of breath/trouble breathing, muscle aches, fatigue, headache, sore throat, runny nose or diarrhea)

Have you travelled out of Canada in the last 14 days?

Does someone you are in close contact with have COVID-19 in your household or workplace?

Are you in close contact with a person who is sick with respiratory symptoms? (fever, cough, or difficulty breathing who recently travelled outside of Canada)?

Were you on Delta 4212 flight into Chippewa County International Airport on March 15, 2020 at approximately 10:45 pm?

Please be prepared to answer these questions. If it is determined you may have been exposed to COVID-19, further steps will be taken to further assist you.

These steps also help ensure staff, clients, patients and visitors of WHC are not potentially exposed.
