






SAFEDRIVE POSTAL STEERING STICK INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


To install the SafeDrive Postal Steering Stick:

- 1. Straighten the steering wheel so the car is driving straight ahead.
- 2. Attach the Steering Stick Clamp around the bottom or top of the steering wheel, as you prefer, and tighten screws using the included allen wrench. It should look like the photo below.
- 3. If the clamp is fully tightened and still twists around the steering wheel, use the included rubber spacers or wrap tape around the steering wheel to make it thicker in that spot and get a tight fit.
- 4. Attach the stick by pushing the probe into the hole. You will hear a small click. Test the connection by trying to pull the stick out. Always test to make sure to lock the stick to the mount before use.
- 5. Sit in the passenger's seat and test the length. Screw the extension on the end and then the ball, or just the ball depending on your preference. Hand tighten while mounted to the steering wheel.
- 6. To release the stick, just press the silver button on top of the clamp while pulling the stick out.

1. Attach the Clamp to the steering wheel as shown



2. Push the probe into the hole to attach the Stick to the Clamp.



3. Press the silver button on the Clamp to remove the Stick



Practice using the SafeDrive Postal Steering Stick in a safe area, preferably an empty parking lot from the passenger's seat while a driver is present in the driver's seat until you are comfortable using it. Practice driving straight and make minor adjustments as if you were driving from mailbox to mailbox. You should also practice making complete 90 degree turns using both hands on the steering stick.

WARNING this product is provided for use at your own risk: Only use the Steering Stick in slow-moving, light traffic conditions. Never drive in heavy or fast-moving traffic from the right side. Always test to make sure the connection to the steering wheel is secure. Always disconnect the stick prior to driving from the driver's side.
